The complainant called the number in the email and talked to a male who advised him to download the "Team Viewer" program on his computer so he could issue a refund. The subject attempted to transfer funds from the complainant's bank account, which was not successful. He advised the complainant that in order to fix his computer, he was to purchase gift cards at Target. The complainant contacted the LCSO and did not purchase gift cards. 11/23/2020 2:30 pm	43000 block Mahala St. Leesburg	Reckless Handling of a Firearm: Deputies responded for a report of an adult male who was suffering from a gunshot wound to the hand. Upon arrival, the complainant reported that he was handling a firearm and unintentionally discharged the weapon striking his hand. He sustained non-life-threatening injuries. This case remains under investigation.

Shopping Safety: ONLINE SHOPPING

Online shopping makes purchasing the perfect gift very easy. But, before you plunge into your online shopping spree, make sure you are taking the proper precautions.

SAFETY TIPS

- If possible, skip using your debit card and stick to credit cards. Credit cards offer more protection.
- Shop secure sites only. The easiest way to tell is to look for "Https" at the beginning of the site's address. If you don't see an "s", then the site is not encrypted and your information is not secure.
- Be on alert for email scams. It is best not to open emails from someone you don't know or a website that you have not visited.
- Before clicking on any link, do your research. Many times these contain viruses.
- Use strong passwords.

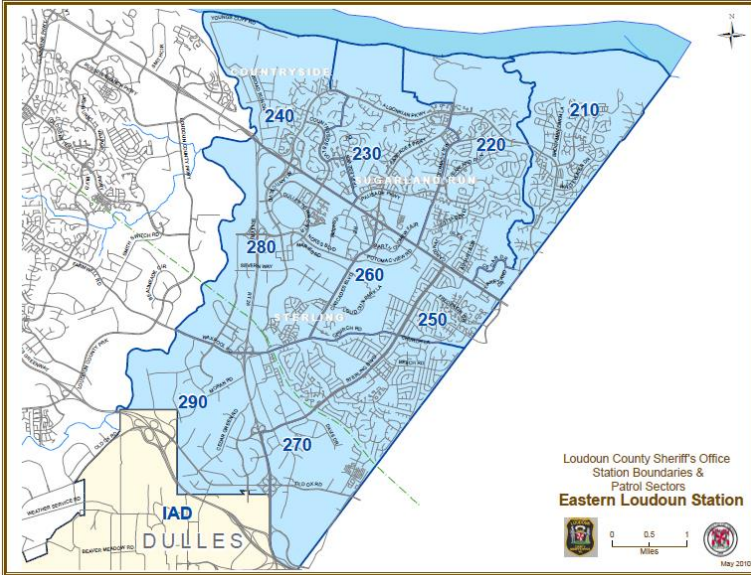

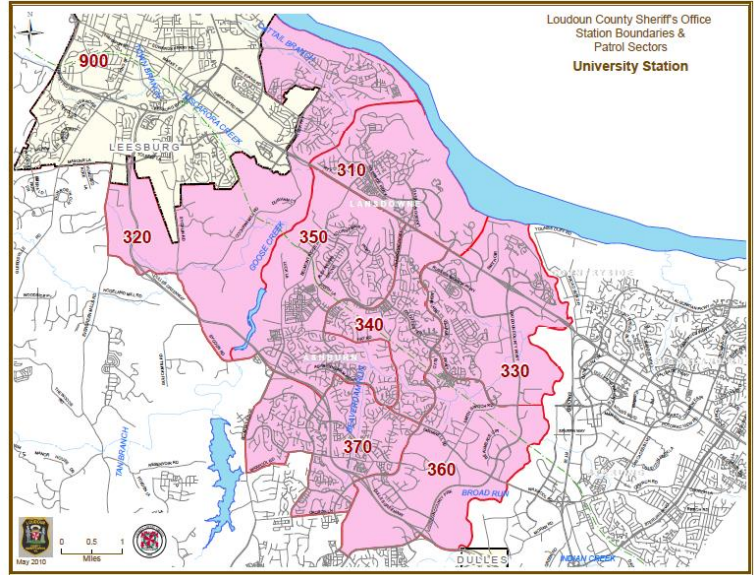

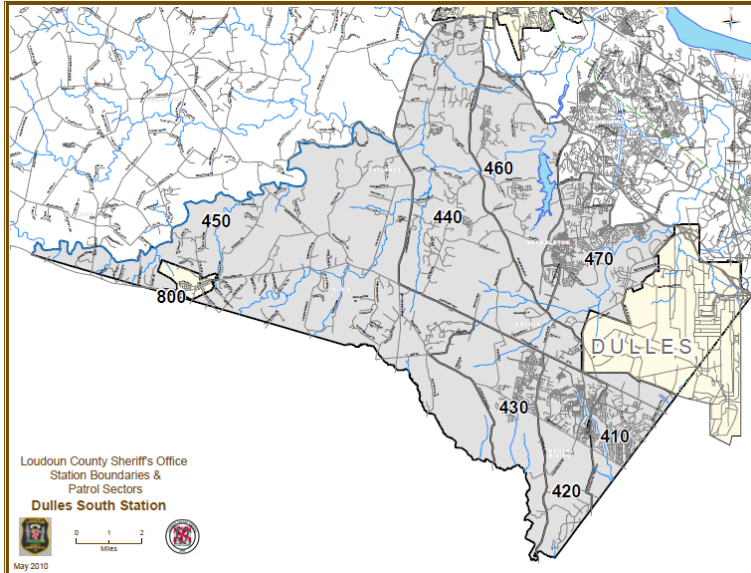
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
