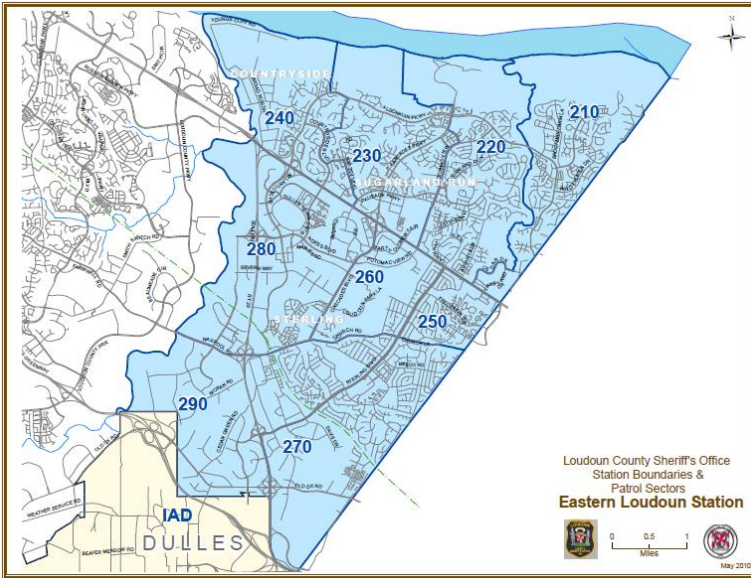

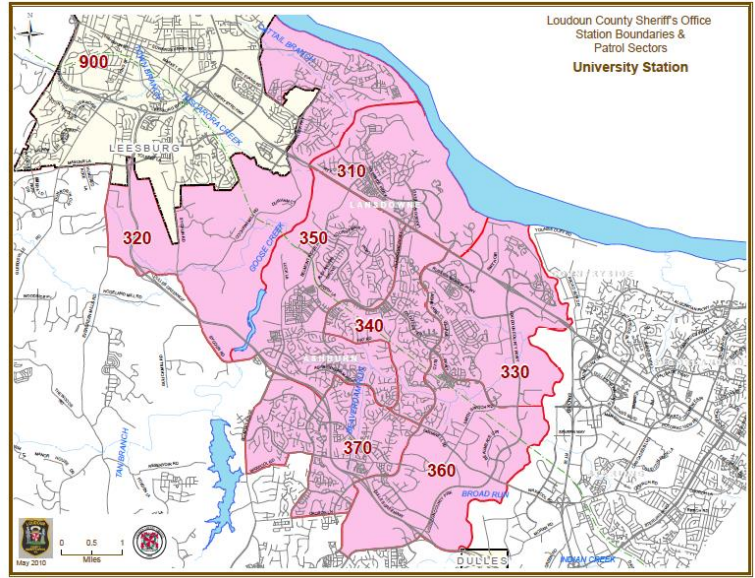

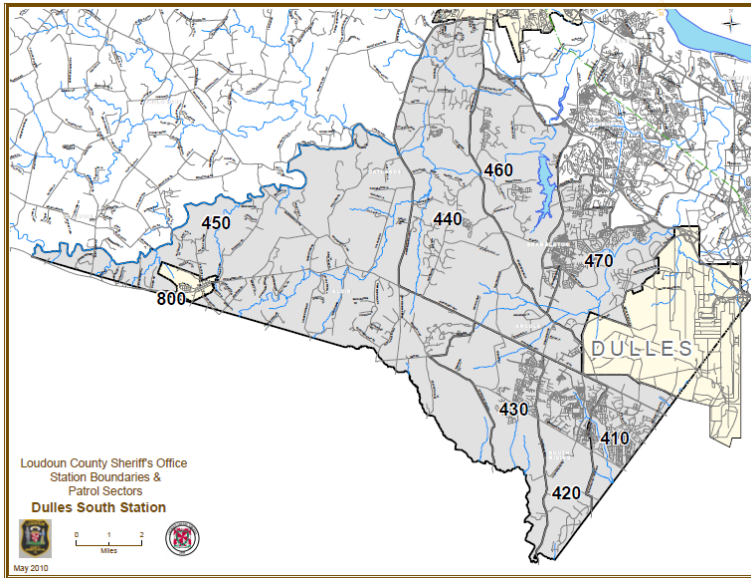
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
