- Statewide pre-registration system launching Feb. 16.

The Virginia Department of Health has announced a Statewide Vaccine Pre-Registration System to provide a unified and comprehensive process for Virginians to pre-register for the COVID-19 vaccine.

VDH has directed all local health districts to close their pre-registration forms and surveys at 5:00

p.m. today, February 12th to allow for existing registration data to be transferred to the new system.

All individuals who previously submitted a pre-screening survey to be vaccinated through the Loudoun County Health Department will be automatically added to the new statewide system.

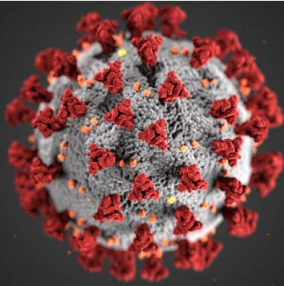
Everyone will maintain their place on the waitlist in Loudoun County

Beginning on Tuesday, February 16, 2021, all pre-registration for COVID-19 vaccine in Virginia will go through the new statewide system.

Even with this change, Loudoun County will continue to systematically work through the waitlist of people who have signed up to receive vaccine. Loudoun County continues to vaccinate people with appointments six days a week. The county is contacting individuals in the order pre-screening survey submissions were received for appointments, as vaccine supplies allow, and in accordance with a state-mandated allocation formula between priority groups.
