The stolen vehicle was determined to have been involved in a two-vehicle crash on Route 50 at Tall Cedars Parkway. The driver of the stolen vehicle had fled the scene. The driver of the second vehicle, a Honda CRV, was reportedly traveling eastbound on a green traffic signal when the driver of the stolen vehicle went through a red traffic signal and the crash occurred. 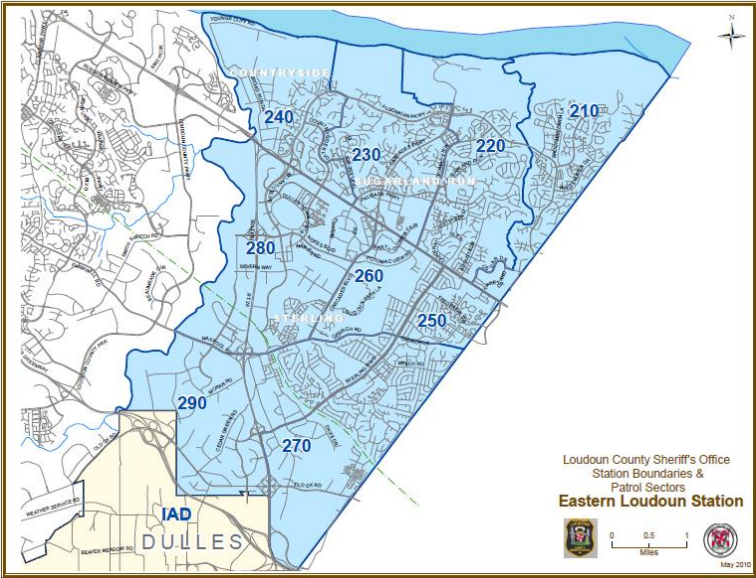

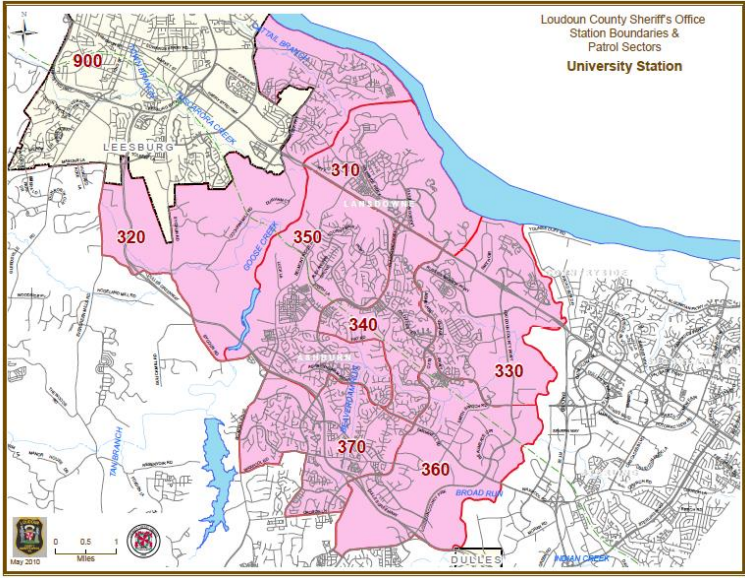

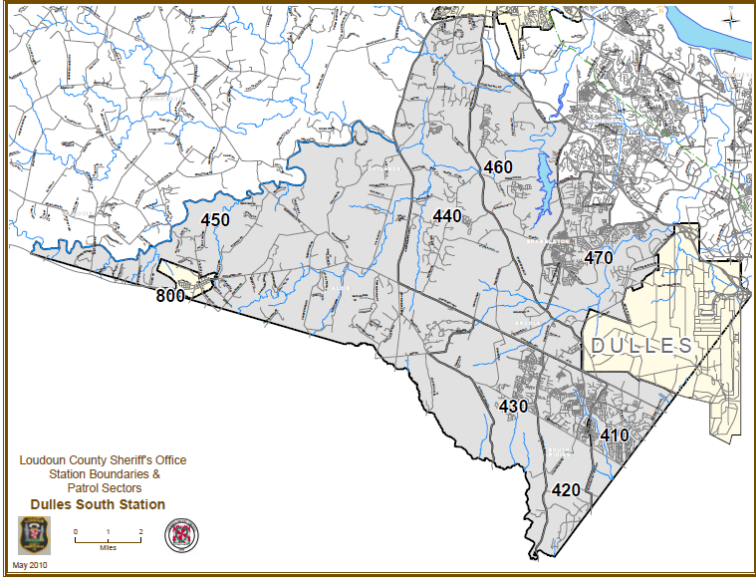
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
