03/19/2021	Chantilly	Government Scam: The complainant reported that she received a call from someone claiming to be from the Department of Justice. The caller stated that her personal information had been compromised and to clear up the matter she had to send money through Bitcoin, which she did. This case remains under investigation. 03/19/2021	Sterling	Social Security Scam: The complainant reported that she received a call from someone claiming to be with an enforcement agency and said that her father's social security number had been compromised. The caller told her to clear up the matter she had to send money through a cash app, which she did. SO2100004437

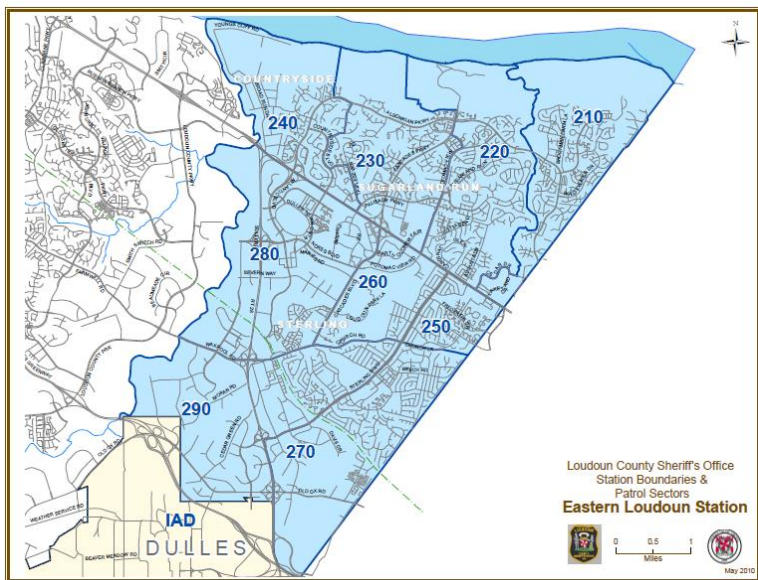

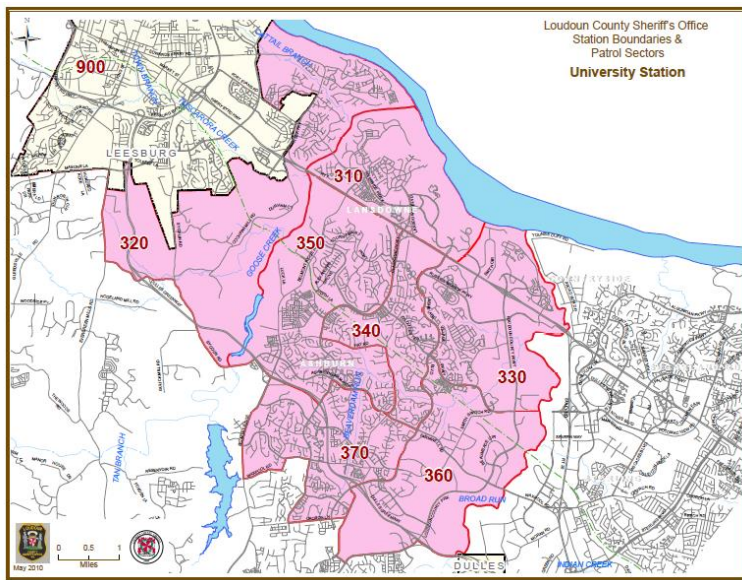

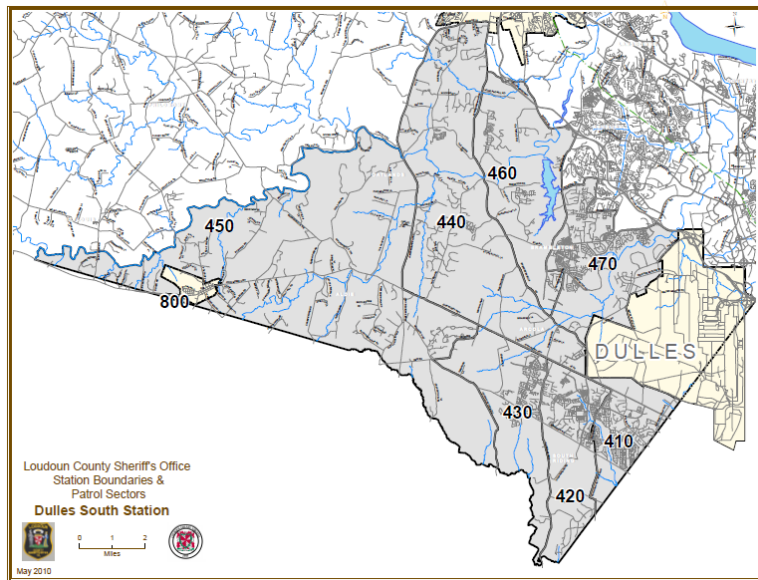
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
