Hillsboro to Expand Two-Way Traffic Openings of Route 9 Thru Town

Per the Town of Hillsboro, its Pedestrian Safety and Traffic Calming project along Route 9 has made great progress and remains ahead of schedule!

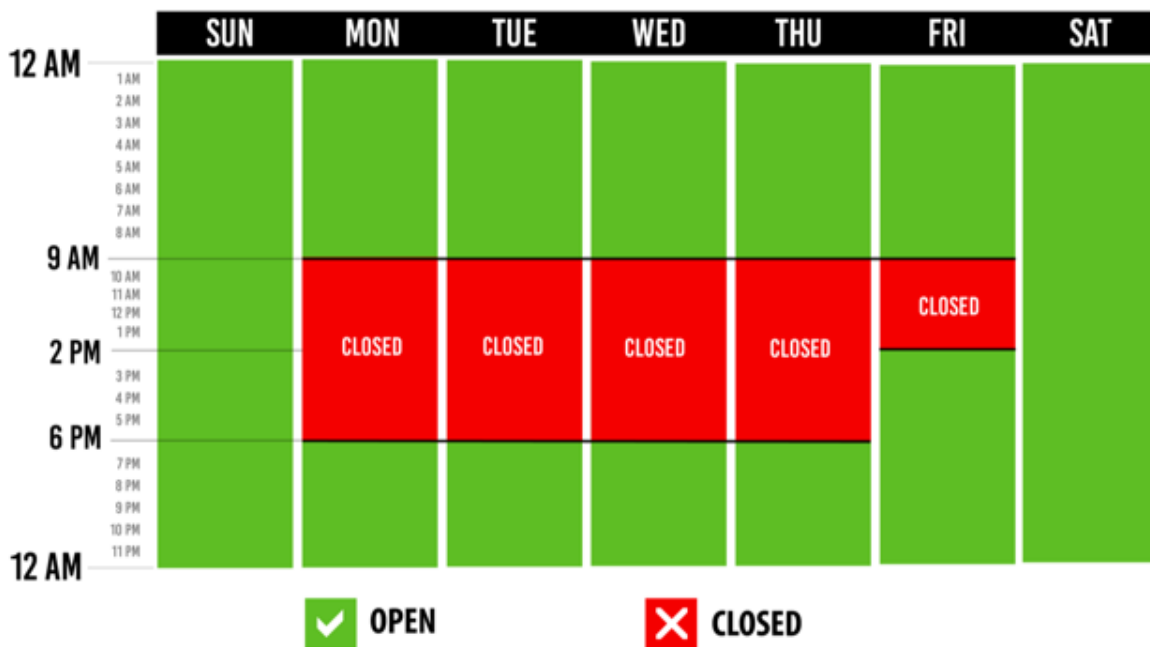
Beginning on Tuesday, March 30th, Hillsboro will expand two-way traffic openings of Route 9 thru Town as follows:

- **Weekends: Fully Open**
- **Monday - Thursday: Only closed from 9 am - 6 pm**
- **Thursday: Only closed from 9 am - 2 pm**

Hillsboro's decision to accelerate the project's opening and to eliminate the final originally approved 30 day road closure, is great news for Loudoun residents, tourists and rural businesses, and comes just in time for the Spring tourism season.

In addition to much needed traffic calming, the Hillsboro project has ensured a new safe drinking water system, storm water management and the beginning of the towns wastewater infrastructure.

The streamlining of these projects into one larger project under Town management has saved taxpayer funding, while enabling the work to be completed years ahead of schedule with less interruptions for motorists.
