Shorter was extradited from Baltimore on March 23 and faces 8 charges in Loudoun County including (2) Bank Note Larceny, (2) Utter Writing, (3) Forge Writing, and (1) Obtain Money by False Pretense. Shorter has also been charged by neighboring jurisdictions with multiple counts of larceny and fraud. Shorter is currently being held without bond at the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center.</p> <p>Original Cases: Larceny / Fraud: The complainant reported that mail was removed from his mailbox and a check was altered and then cashed. The complainant was able to provide a detailed description of the suspect and deputies were able to locate him.</p> <p>Multiple items were found on the subject that deputies believe were taken from vehicles in the area.</p> <p>Lionel E. 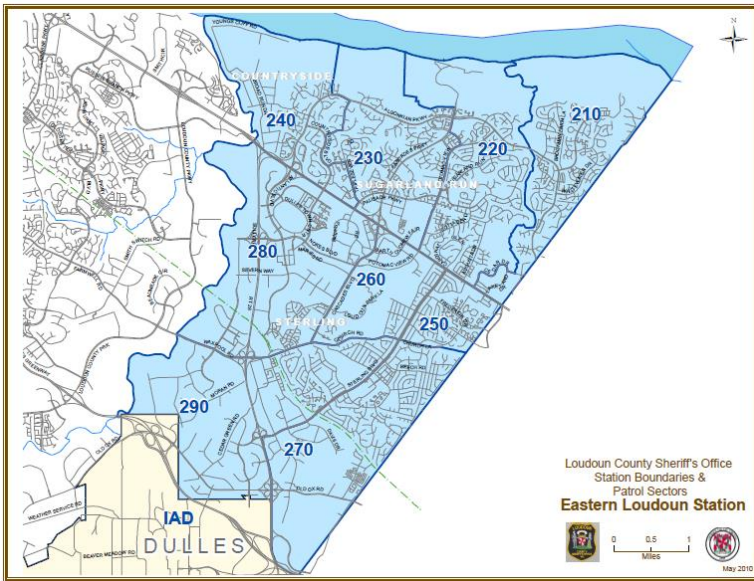

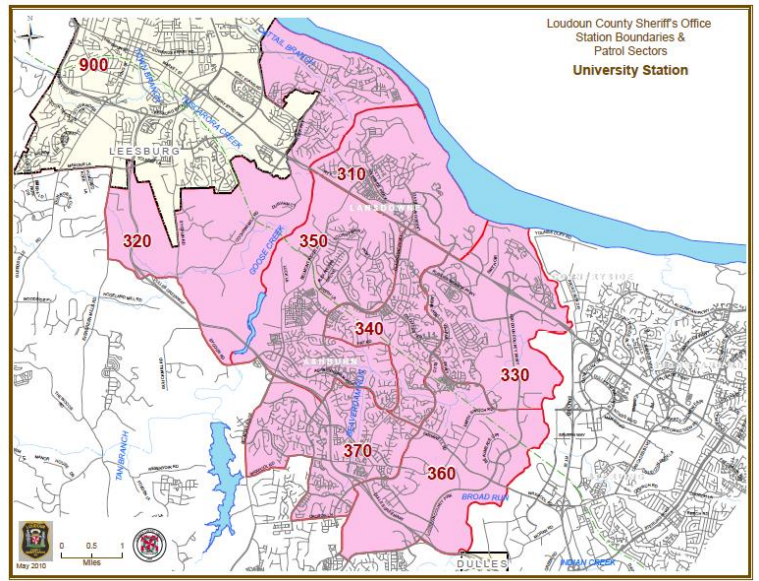

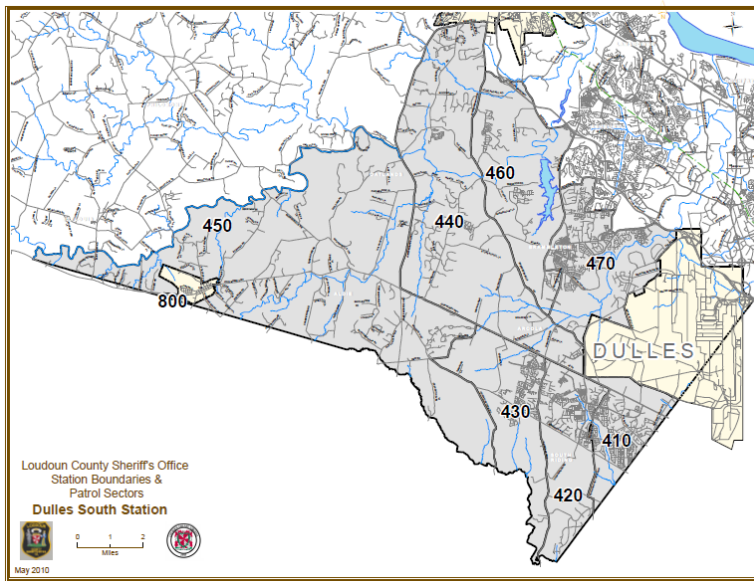
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
