Here is a list of useful tips to help you buy and sell safely on sites such as Facebook Marketplace and Craigslist.

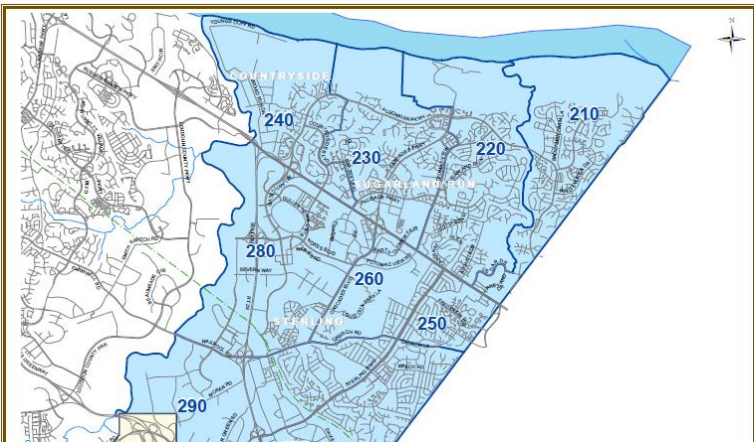
1. Buy and Sell Locally.

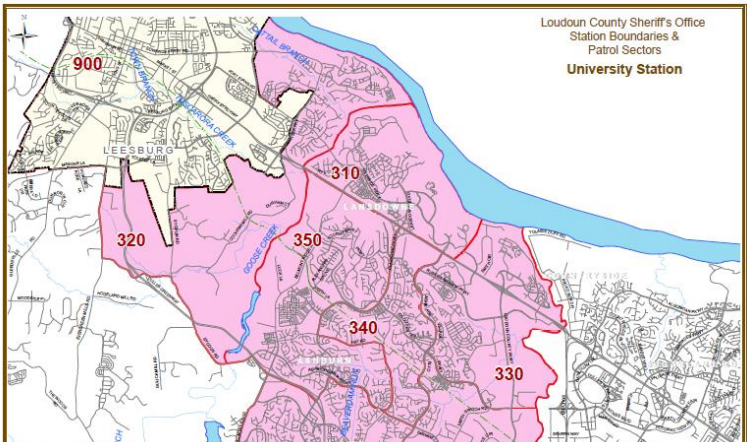


Station / Sector Maps

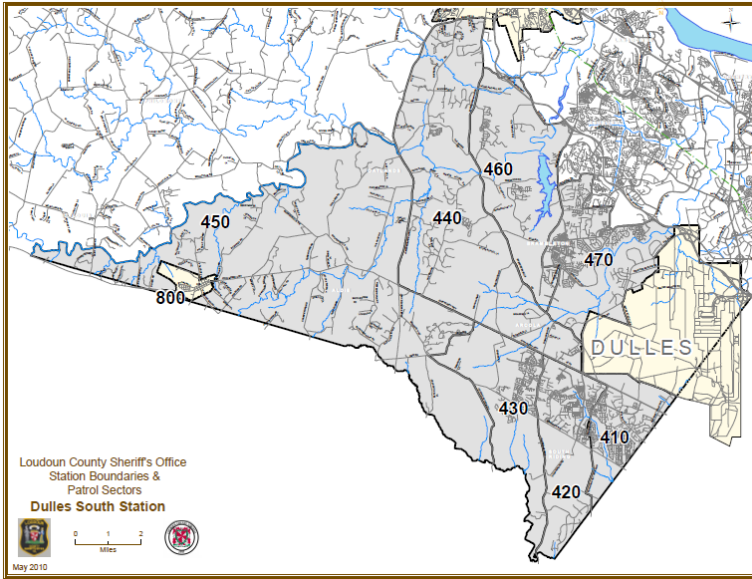
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
