03/31/2021	Aldie	Microsoft Scam: The complainant reported that she received a message on her computer that she had a virus and to call a phone number. The complainant called the phone number and gave permission for a male on the other line to access her computer. The male was able to gain access to her banking information and told her to clear up the account she was to purchase gift cards, which she did. SO2100005128

Safety Tips / Announcements

AMAZON SCAM

Someone made a purchase using your Amazon account?

Someone claiming to be from the online retailer, Amazon, calls you or sends you an email saying fraudulent purchases were made using your account. They ask you to click the link included in the email so they can assist you with fixing the problem.

Once you click the link, the scammer has access to your computer. The scammer then tries to convince you that they over refunded you the purchase amount and asks you to cash app them the difference or go out and purchase gift cards and provide them the information. When you check your bank account there was never a deposit in your account and you are out the money.

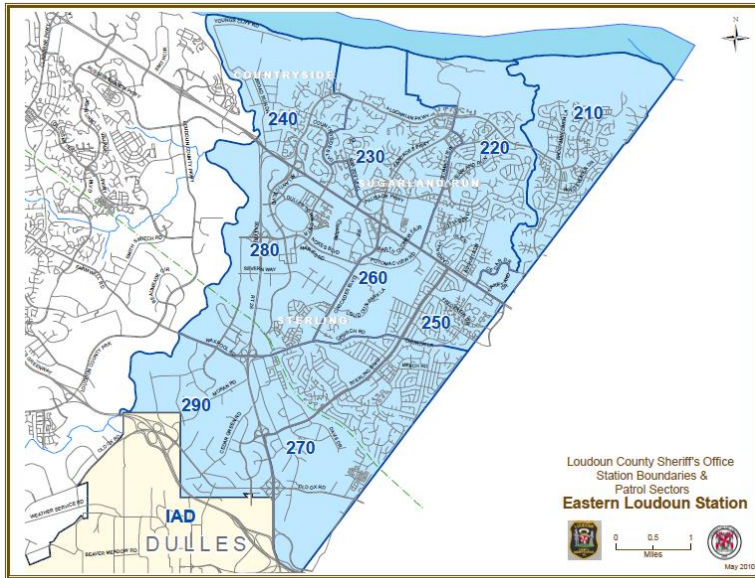


If you are contacted by someone pretending to be from Amazon or any retailer saying your account was hacked - do not click on any links.

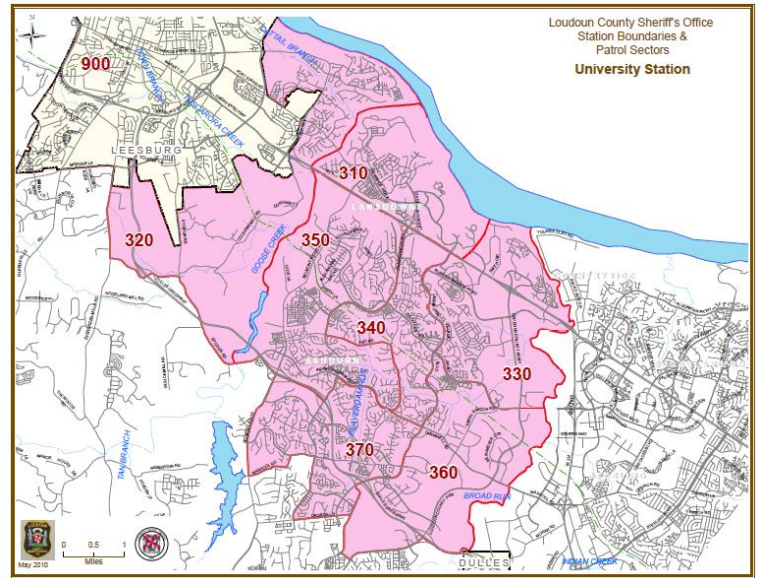

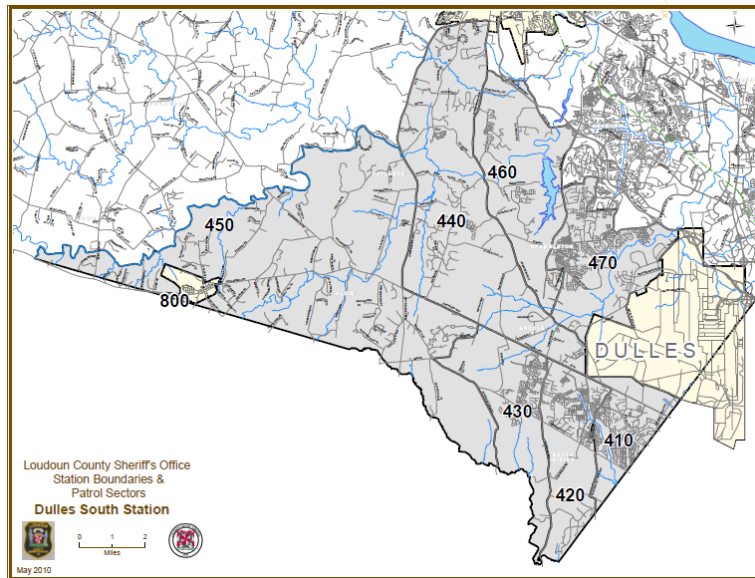
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
