For Drivers

For Bicyclists

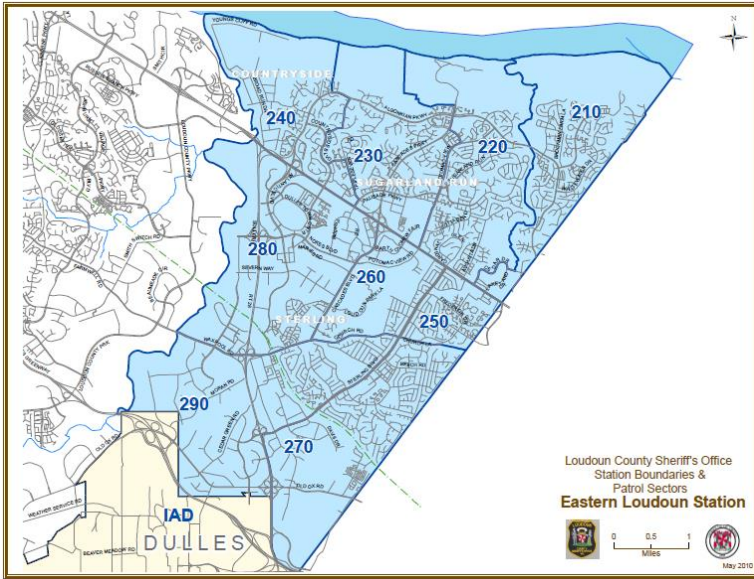
- Obey all regulatory signs and traffic lights.

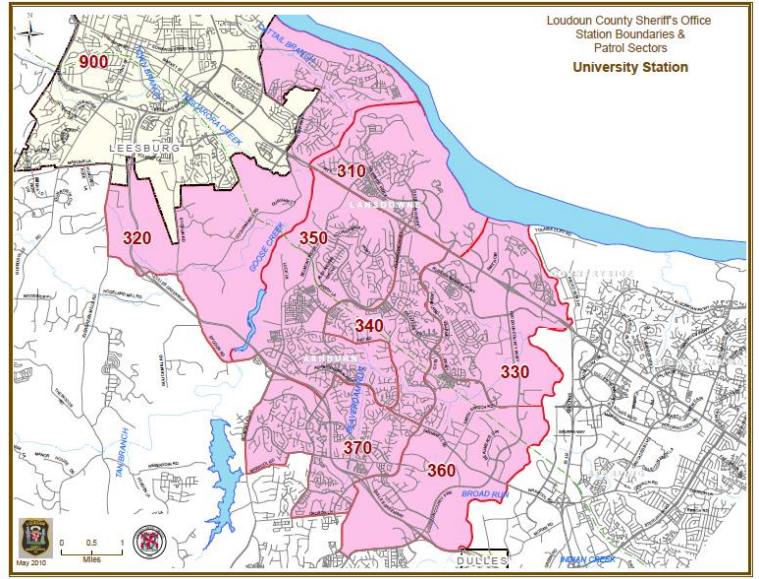


Station / Sector Maps

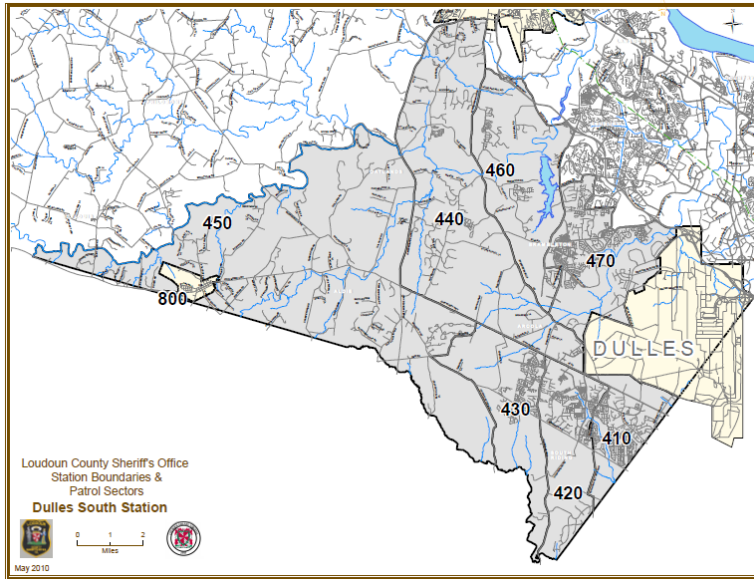
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
