Upon arrival deputies talked with a male subject who provided them with identification. A wanted check came back that the male was wanted and not licensed. When deputies advised the subject that he was under arrest, he began to resist. After placing the male under arrest, it was determined he had provided deputies with a false name and identification. GARAGES & SHEDS

All too often we see garage doors and sheds left open. It only takes a few seconds for a thief to remove items such as bikes, tools, coolers, shopping bags, etc. Here are a couple of tips to help keep your valuables safe.

- If you park a vehicle in the garage, make sure your vehicle is kept locked at all times and remove any items of value.
- Make sure your garage, shed, and any other out buildings are secured and locked, even if you are home. Engage the garage door slide lock when you will be away for an extended time.

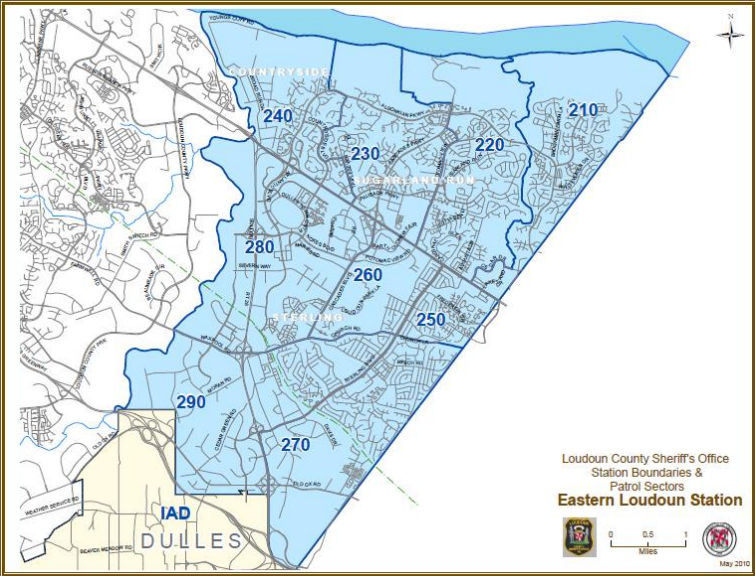


- Install a deadbolt on the door between the garage and your home and keep it locked.
- If there are windows, cover them so that a potential thief cannot see inside.
- Install a security camera and motion sensing lights pointed towards entry points of your home.
- Keep tools and others items of value out of sight.

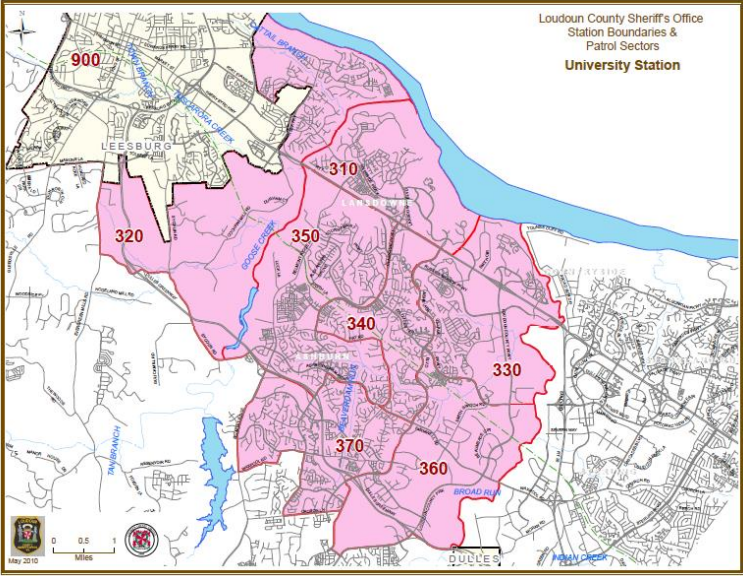

Station / Sector Maps

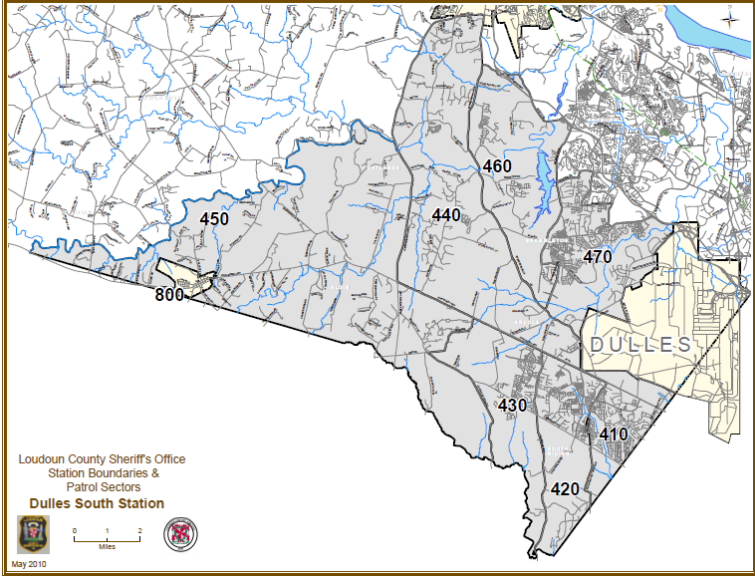
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
