



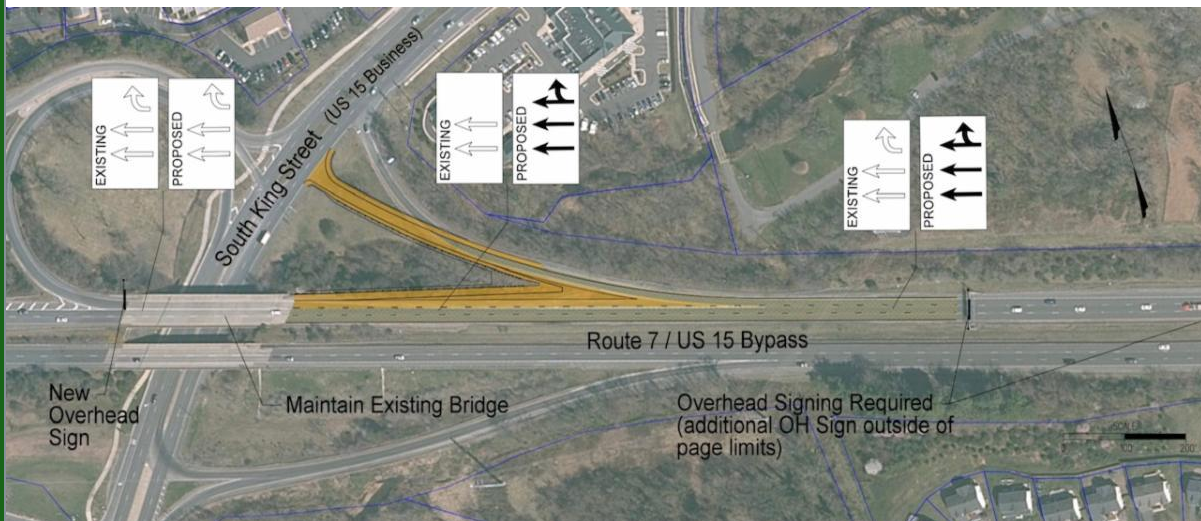

Westbound Route 7 Leesburg Bypass Improvement Project

Safety improvement and traffic congestion relief project to begin soon

Sent: April 8, 2021



This road safety and congestion reduction project is a coordinated effort between TRIP II (Greenway), VDOT, the Town of Leesburg, and Loudoun County.

This project will construct a third westbound lane on the Route 7/Route 15 Bypass, approximately .40 miles in length, beginning at the end point of the westbound Dulles Greenway exit ramp and ending just before the bridge over Route 15.

The project will also reconfigure the geometry of the existing South King Street exit ramp.

The goal of this project is to improve safety and reduce traffic congestion.

Anticipated Project Timeline:

- **Notice to Proceed was issued in March of 2021.**
- **VDOT Land Use Permit is anticipated to be issued in April of 2021.**
- **Construction is expected to begin upon issuance of VDOT Land Use Permit.**
- **Substantial Project Completion is anticipated to occur by the end of December, 2021.**

The construction contract for this project has been awarded to Shirley Contracting.
