SUBJECT: Response to Board Member Initiative: Proposed Traffic Calming on John Mosby Highway (Route 50) in Village of Aldie

PURPOSE: To seek authorization from the Board of Supervisors (Board) for the installation of pole mounted speed display (PMSD) signs on John Mosby Highway (Route 50) within the Village of Aldie in the Blue Ridge Election District and its perpetual maintenance by the Department of General Services (DGS) and to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) by authorizing the transfer of \$115,000 from the CIP Contingency account through the Traffic Calming Contingency account to the Aldie PMSD Signs Route 50 project in the Capital Projects Fund.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board authorize the installation of PMSD signs on Route 50 in the Village of Aldie in the Blue Ridge Election District and its perpetual maintenance by DGS, and to amend the FY 2021 CIP by authorizing the transfer of \$115,000 from the CIP Contingency account through the Traffic Calming Contingency account to the Aldie PMSD Signs Route 50 project in the Capital Projects Fund.

Many thanks to my colleagues for unanimously passing our Rt 50 traffic calming efforts through the Village of Aldie.

Improvements will include addition of pole mounted speed display signs and additional fines of \$200 for speeders.
