Hillsboro Announces Route 9 Now Open Full Time

All major roadway work now complete

On Thursday, May 27, the Town of Hillsboro [announced](#) the on-time and on-budget re-opening of 24/7, two-way traffic through Hillsboro on Charles Town Pike.

Hillsboro's [ReThink9](#) Traffic Calming, Pedestrian Safety, Congestion Mitigation & Infrastructure Project is an important project for the entire region and I'm honored to have played a small role in its completion in 14 months. I want to recognize Mayor Vance and Vice Mayor Marasco for their efforts to ensure this timely and on-budget completion of the road work along Route 9.

While the Charles Town Pike infrastructure and traffic-calming aspects of ReThink9 are now finished, additional Hillsboro infrastructure projects continue, including the extension of drinking water mains, sewer mains, and Town communications conduit along the Town's four other roads; three multimodal trails; and construction of the Town's new postal kiosk at the historic Lawson-Goodrich House, according to the project [website](#).

Hillsboro's new wastewater treatment package plant, currently under design, is expected to be completed by March of 2022.

About ReThink9:

This project constructs traffic calming and congestion mitigation, pedestrian safety, utility and water/wastewater improvements along Route 9 through the Town of Hillsboro. Improvements include roundabouts on both sides of town, traffic calming streetscaping, sidewalks and multi-use trails, safe on-street parking, burial of overhead utility lines, replacement of an antiquated water system (main, meters and laterals), installation of a storm water sewer system, and installation of sanitary sewer main and laterals. All elements of the project are being delivered simultaneously in order to reduce cost and minimize impacts on traffic, businesses, and area residents.



The project is being administered by the Town of Hillsboro with design and construction management being handled by Volkert Engineering.
