Virtual Public Input Meeting for Road Safety Improvements in the Village of Lucketts

Dear Lucketts residents,

VDOT is hosting a virtual public information meeting on **Thursday, July 29**, at **6:30 PM** about safety improvements that they'll be making along Route 15 in the Village of Lucketts. The project team will give a short presentation, then answer questions from the public for about an hour.

These safety improvements will include:

- Adding new sidewalks
- Enhancing the pedestrian crossing by the northern Lucketts Elementary School entrance
- Striping a new crosswalk with pedestrian signals at the Stumptown Road (Route 662) intersection
- Modifying the right-turn lane to Lucketts Road (Route 662)

NOTE: As I mentioned in my [June newsletter](#), this meeting is only about safety improvements *within* the Village of Lucketts, so it will not include information relating to the Route 15 Improvement Project or the realignment of Route 15 around Lucketts.

Joining the Meeting

On WebEx: If you'd like to join the meeting using WebEx, register ahead of time by going to the [sign-up page](#), filling in your name and email address, and clicking Submit. You'll get a confirmation email with a link that will let you enter the WebEx meeting.

By Phone: You can call in to the meeting and participate in listen-only mode. To do that, dial **1-866-692-4530**. When the phone tree asks you for your access code, enter **161-319-0436**.

You can ask questions directly to VDOT's project team at the meeting. Just [register](#) for the meeting, and then sign in on Thursday at 6:30.

You can also send your written questions and comments to VDOT, up through August 9, at meetingcomments@vdot.virginia.gov.

Finally, VDOT has set up an [online survey](#), which you can fill out and submit. That survey will stay open through August 9.
