Residents and business owners are encouraged to provide input to Loudoun's Environmental Commission on local environmental and sustainability issues. The Commission will consider this input when drafting its draft Environmental Strategy recommendations to be considered by the Board of Supervisors in early 2022.

The meeting will seek public input on the following 5 Key Topic Areas:

- **Energy sustainability, including clean and renewable energy usage. If you have an opinion on whether or not large ground-mounted solar array fields should be allowed in rural Loudoun, please share your opinion on this issue with the Commission during this meeting. Personally, I am concerned with the idea of allowing large ground-mounted solar array fields within our rural areas and would**

rather see them limited to smaller areas within each rural property that are properly screened from public view, along with an allowance for roof-mounted solar on homes, barns and other detached structures.

- **Enhancing natural resources, such as trees, wildlife, watersheds, and land conservation**
- **Environmental justice, which examines the impact of environmental issues on underserved populations**
- **“Government by example,” which includes programs to enhance the sustainability of Loudoun County government operations**
- **Increasing public engagement in environmental and sustainability initiatives**
