## Give Your Feedback on County Redistricting

Dear Catoctin residents,

Loudoun has received a slew of redistricting proposals from members of the public, county staff, and Board members. (Thank you to everyone who sent one in!) Our staff then subjected all of those proposals to a review process. Twenty of them made it through.

Now we need your feedback. At this point, we have [twenty plausible plans](#) for redrawing Loudoun County's district lines. On **January 18**, the Board will meet to cut our current slate of plans down to a short list, which we'll send back to county staff for a second round of detailed review and refining. We would love to get your thoughts on the plans before then.

Here's my short guide on how to view the plans and send in your feedback.

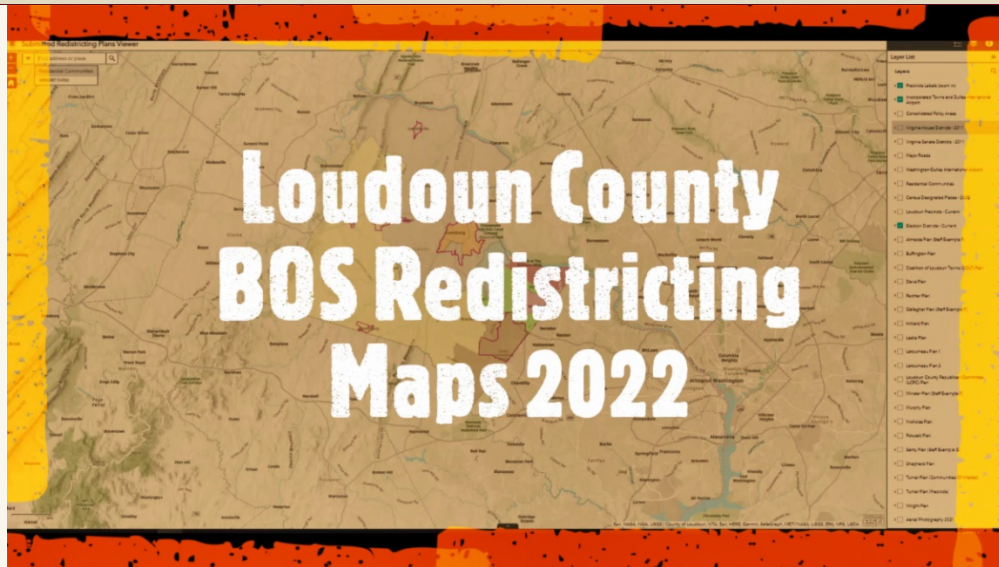

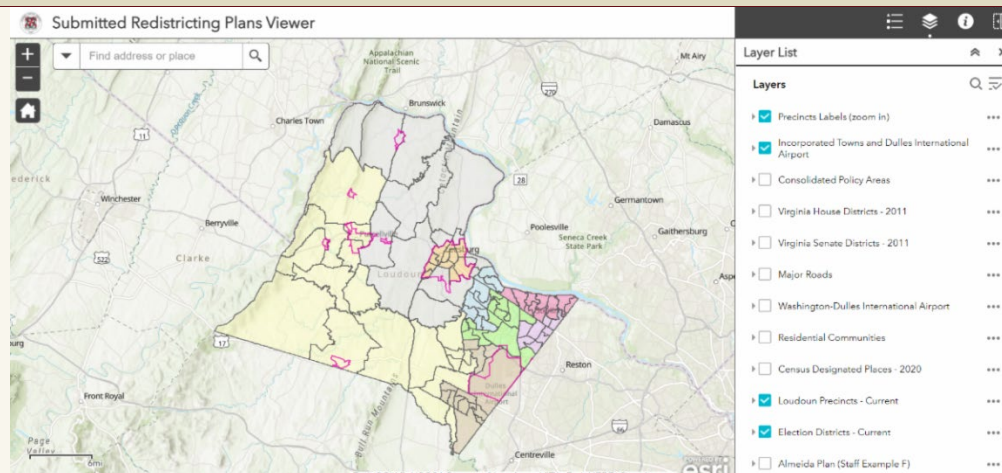

## Dig Into the Proposal Details

When you're ready to dive deeper, you can view the plans on Loudoun's [Submitted Redistricting Plans Viewer](#). Clicking on the link should take you to a mapping screen that looks like the image above.

You can view the plans by using that panel on the right that's labeled "Layer List." These are layers on the map that you can turn on or off. I personally like to turn off the "Election Districts - Current" layer (which is turned on by default), then click the little checkbox for one redistricting proposal at a time.

This mapping tool lets you zoom in and out, and lets you look up specific addresses to see where they'd wind up in a particular redistricting plan.

## Next Steps in the Redistricting Process

We need your feedback before the Board meets on **January 18**. At that meeting, the Board will decide which redistricting proposals to put on our short list. We will then hand that short list to our Mapping Department, who will do a deep-dive assessment of each one. Among other things, they will be looking to assess how each plan would impact communities of interest (these are groups of people who would benefit from remaining in a single district), and how the plan's boundary lines overlay the county's policy areas.

Mapping will bring their analysis back to the Board in February. We'll consider that analysis very carefully. Then in March, the Board will select the redistricting plan that we think is the best one, and we'll forward it to a public hearing in May.
