This virtual "pardon our dust" meeting will provide the public with information regarding the stages of construction of Belmont Ridge Road Improvements. This project funds the design, land acquisition and construction of the reconstruction and widening of Belmont Ridge Road between Truro Parish Drive and Croson Lane from an existing two lane rural road to a four lane median divided suburban roadway with shared use paths on each side.

When complete, this project will reduce congestion and improve operation and safety for vehicles and pedestrians on this critical north-south corridor in Ashburn, Va.

Groundbreaking Ceremony

Loudoun County has scheduled a **Ceremonial Groundbreaking** on **Thursday, January 27, 2022, at 11:45 a.m. at Edgar Tillet Memorial Park, 21561 Belmont Ridge Rd, Ashburn**, with members of the Board of Supervisors, the NVTA, and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) on hand.

Other Project News

- Land acquisition, easements, right-of-way, and design are all 100% complete.
- A construction kick-off meeting was held in November 2021, following the construction contract award. Notice to Proceed (NTP) with construction is currently scheduled for this month (January 2022).
- The construction phase is anticipated to last approximately 30 months, with substantial project completion anticipated for Summer of 2025.

About the Project

This project designs and constructs two additional lanes of Belmont Ridge Road from Truro Parish Drive to Croson Lane. The improvements will consist of reconstructing and widening the existing two-lane road to a four-lane divided roadway with a ten (10) foot shared use path on both sides of the road.

The Project includes two northbound and two southbound lanes, associated turn lanes at the intersections of Croson Lane, Cochrans Lock Drive, Reservoir Ridge Place, Mount Hope Road, Waxpool Road, Black Angus Drive, Truro Parish Drive, a 42-foot-wide grass median, stormwater management facilities, landscaping, and modifications to the existing traffic signals at Croson Lane and Truro Parish Drive.
