
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Crime Report


Eastern Loudoun Station

5/31/16	0 Block Pigeon Hill Dr Sterling	Destruction of Property: The complainant reported that a student assaulted a teacher and damaged property inside a private school classroom. The student fled the scene but was later located by LCSO. The suspect was identified as Christopher L. Butts, 19, of Leesburg. Butts was arrested and charged with Assault and Felony Destruction of Property. Butts is being held at the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center on bond.


University Station (Sectors 310, 320, 330, 340, 350, 360, 370, 900)

5/31/16 0650 hrs	20000 Block Claiborne Pkwy Ashburn	Destruction of Property/Larceny: Multiple buses at a school had their doors damaged and five fire extinguishers were stolen.
5/31/16 0650 hrs	22000 Block Belmont Ridge Rd Ashburn	Destruction of Property/Larceny Multiple buses at a school had their doors damaged and six fire extinguishers were stolen.
5/31/16 0650 hrs	44000 Block Gloucester Pkwy Ashburn	Destruction of Property/Larceny: Multiple buses at a school had their doors damaged and two fire extinguishers were stolen.



5/31/16 0947 hrs	24000 Block Stone Springs Blvd Aldie	Destruction of Property: The complainant stated that a rear window of the abandoned building was damaged and multiple walls were damaged with spray paint.

A deputy was the first to arrive on scene and recognized the indications of a potential heroin overdose. The deputy administered NARCAN and the adult male was revived. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment. The case remains under investigation.
