## Real Estate Tax Relief Seminars

The Commissioner of the Revenue is holding information sessions about the county's real estate tax relief program.

Join Loudoun County Commissioner of the Revenue Robert Wertz at one of the free residential information sessions focused on the eligibility criteria for the county's real estate tax relief program.

Sessions begin at 10:30 am at the following dates and locations:

- **Wednesday, March 9, 2022: Cascades Library** (21030 Whitfield Place, Potomac Falls)
- **Tuesday, March 15, 2022: Purcellville Library** (220 East Main Street, Purcellville)
- **Friday, March 25, 2022: Ashburn Library** (43316 Hay Road, Ashburn)
- **Tuesday, March 29, 2022: Rust Library** (380 Old Waterford Road, NW, Leesburg)

Have your questions answered about the county's tax relief program at these free, upcoming sessions. No appointment or RSVP is required to attend.

**Loudoun County homeowners 65 or older or with disabilities who are below established income and wealth limits may benefit from a reduction in the amount of property taxes they pay.** In July 2021, the Board of Supervisors raised the program's upper income limits. Qualified applicants for real estate relief must have a gross combined income less than \$77,000 and net worth less than \$920,000. Up to \$10,000 in income of a spouse or relative residing in the home is excluded from the income calculation. Program participants saved almost \$8 million in real estate taxes last year.

**Tax Relief for Disabled Veterans Programs:**

Disabled veterans and their surviving spouse may be eligible for Real Property Tax or Personal Property Tax relief programs.

**Real Property Tax Exemption: Disabled Veterans**

Disabled veterans and their surviving spouse may be exempt from paying real property taxes on their dwelling, some additional structures, and land up to three acres. Manufactured homes (mobile homes) may qualify for the exemption. The land in excess of three acres is ineligible for the exemption.

**Personal Property Tax Exemption: Disabled Veterans**

Disabled veterans may be exempt from paying personal property taxes on one vehicle (i.e. car or truck). This exemption does not apply to the yearly Vehicle License Fee (VLF).
