



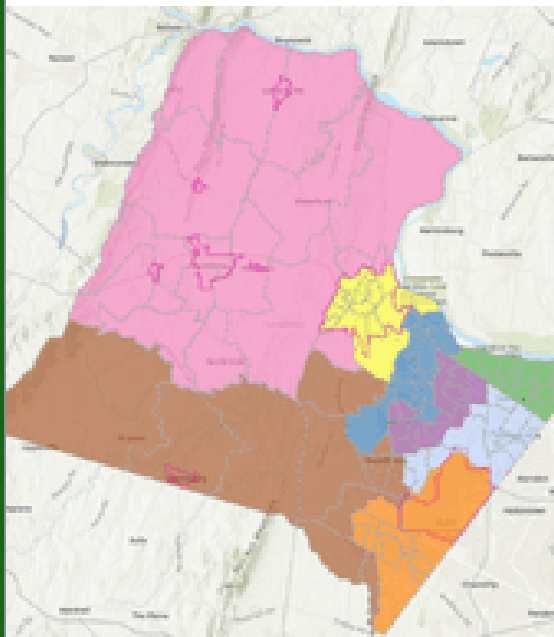

Loudoun Redistricting Process Update

Redistricting Process Background

My goals throughout the redistricting process have been to ensure:

- **Western Loudoun maintains two representatives.**
- **The Brambleton HOA is redistricted into an eastern District.**

As previously stated, I believe the Buffington or COLT Plans would have best accomplished these goals; however, despite numerous public comments of support from residents and organizations, my colleagues voted to end further consideration of these plans and selected only the Letourneau/Turner Plan for further consideration.

When the Letourneau/Turner Plan was initially selected as the only plan for further consideration, it did not include two portions of Brambleton nor the Saint Louis Precinct of western Loudoun within District 7 (the brown colored District on the above map). In an effort to increase the likelihood of positive future representation for western Loudoun and to incorporate as much of the Brambleton HOA as possible within one District I supported amendments to add the Saint Louis Precinct and the Birchwood at Brambleton community into District 7. These and other amendments were supported by the Board and included in an updated Plan called the Letourneau/Turner Revised 1 Plan.

At the Board's April 5, 2022, Business Meeting a majority of the Board voted to send only the Letourneau/Turner Revised 1 Plan to the upcoming May 11, 2022, Public Hearing, for public comment and further consideration by the Board.

Blue Ridge District Renaming

The current Blue Ridge District is changing significantly and will be renamed as part of the redistricting process. As with the proposed District boundaries, the public will also be able to comment on the future name of District 7 (the brown colored District on the above map) between now and the May 11, 2022, Public Hearing.

The two names being considered are:

- **Little River District**
- **Evergreen District**

Currently, I believe "Little River District" to be the most appropriate name for this newly formed district as the Little River runs north/south through the center of the district and the county is pursuing a name change of John Mosby Highway (Route 50) to Little River Turnpike (Route 50), which runs east-west through this future district. That said, I will reserve final judgement on this until I've heard all public comment on the matter.

Remaining Redistricting Process Steps:

- May 11 Public Hearing: Board most likely adopts the Letourneau/Turner Revised 1 Plan as the next Board of Supervisor and School Board District map.
- By July 27, 2022: New Districts implemented upon completion of required judicial process.
