He was known as having a huge heart, the best hugs, and a solid moral center. Adam was smart, quick-witted, funny, athletic, and patriotic. The community recognized Adam riding his red Trek mountain bike through the streets of Purcellville. Adam loved Purcellville and loved that bike.

The Caudill Family has organized a group of volunteers, along with 100% support from the Town Council and generous grant funding, to develop Purcellville's first bike park. Adam's Bike Park will be free for all to use, on a one-acre lot that will be connected to the W&OD Trail. The bike park will also be accessible from N. Maple Ave, directly across from Loudoun Valley High School.
