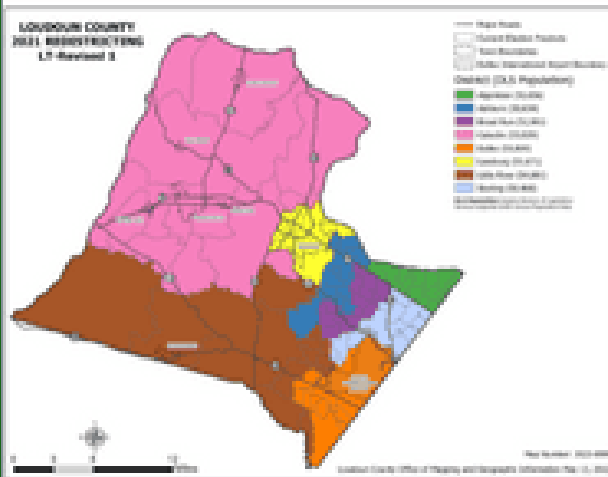
Loudoun Redistricting Process Update

Board to Vote on Letourneau/Turner Plan on June 7

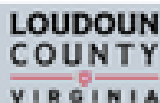
Redrawn Blue Ridge District to be Renamed

Local Redistricting Update



- Supervisors conclude public hearing on local election district plan with no changes to map.
- District 7 will be Little River District.
- Plan to be considered for adoption June 7, 2022.

Many thanks to everyone to date who has shared their thoughts and suggestions regarding the Board's public redistricting process. As stated above, the Board is expected to take a final vote on adoption of the [Letourneau/Turner Plan](#) at its June 7, 2022, Business Meeting.

As most of you know by now, this is a federally mandated public process that occurs every 10 years following the Census for purposes of electing local Board of Supervisor and School Board representatives.

Redrawn Blue Ridge District to be Renamed as the "Little River District"

While the names of the County's 7 other election districts will remain the same, the Board voted to rename the redrawn Blue Ridge District (the brown in color District on the map above) as the "Little River District".

I support this renaming as the actual Little River runs north/south through the center of the proposed District and the County is pursuing a name change of Route 50 to Little River Turnpike, which runs east/west through this future District.

Remaining Steps in Redistricting Process

- The Board of Supervisors is scheduled to vote on adoption of the Letourneau/Turner Plan during its regularly scheduled Business Meeting on **June 7, 2022, at 5:00 pm** at the Loudoun County Government Center. To view meeting documents and watch the live stream of the meeting, visit loudoun.gov/meetings
- If adopted, the Plan will be sent to the Commonwealth of Virginia for approval. If approved by the state, the Loudoun County Office of Elections and Voter Registration will adjust precincts as necessary and establish updated polling places in accordance with the

adopted election District plan. All Loudoun County registered voters will receive information by mail from the Office of Elections and Voter Registration to notify voters of any changes in their precincts, precinct numbers or election Districts.

- The newly drawn districts will become official following the state's approval of Loudoun's Election District Plan. For voting purposes the Plan will be implemented immediately following the November 2022 election.
