**WHEN: Thursday, June 16, at 11:00 a.m.**

**WHERE: On the future site of the facility near the intersection of Carolina Wren Drive and Coopers Hawk Drive in Ashburn. (Use 21440 Coopers Hawk Drive, Ashburn, to arrive at the general location using GPS.)**

Join members of the Board of Supervisors and Parks, Recreation and Community Services staff to kick off construction of this project.

### **About the Project**

This project will construct a 117,000-square-foot recreation and community center on Broadlands Boulevard, west of the intersection with Claiborne Parkway.

The two-story facility will include many features:

#### **Indoor Features:**

- 50-meter competition pool with spectator seating
- Classrooms, offices, and meeting spaces
- Fitness areas
- Full-size gymnasium
- Leisure pool
- Multipurpose room with a catering and teaching kitchen.
- One indoor basketball gymnasium, with six basketball hoops, and game line markings for basketball, volleyball and pickleball
- Running track
- Soft sensory playroom
- Spa

#### **Outdoor Features:**

- Large courtyard with seating
- Multiuse trail around the property
- Playground equipment
- Splash play area

**Construction is currently estimated for completion in Summer of 2025.**

Note: Many of the same amenities, such as a fitness center, multi-purpose rooms, a running track, and an aquatics center, will be included in the future **Western Loudoun Recreation Center**, which I strongly support and was able to have added as a new project to the County's 6-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) planning and funding document.

While a specific location for the future Western Loudoun Recreation Center has yet to be identified, I am working to ensure the future facility is located in or near the Towns of Purcellville or Round Hill as this general area is easily accessible from Route 7 and centrally located near the majority of western Loudoun residents.

In addition to having the project added as a new project to the County's 6-Year CIP, I was able to gain support from my colleagues as part of last year's FY 2022 CIP budget process to accelerate initial funding for the project into FY 2024.
