

### Eastern Loudoun Station



7/22/16 2319 hrs.	46000 Block Eaton Ter. Sterling	Obstruction of Justice/Drunk in Public: LCSO Deputies responded for report of a loud yelling at this location. When Deputies arrived they observed the apartment door open and a disorderly/intoxicated male exited. The subject walked towards the deputies and refused to comply with lawful commands. Deputies took the subject into custody after a short physical struggle. The subject was identified as Bryan A. Fountain, 25, of Sterling. Fountain was arrested and charged with Obstruction of Justice by Force and Drunk in Public. He was released from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center on a personal recognizance bond.

The victims on scene reported that two males were escorted from the business via security and threaten to shoot the victims. The subjects were identified as Jose Armando Portillo-Lopez, 28, of Silver Spring, MD and Arnaldo Portillo-Lopez, 30, of College Park, MD. Both males were arrested and charged with Disorderly Conduct and Drunk in Public. Both males were released from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center on a personal recognizance bond.

When the victim returned to the vehicle they noticed that loose change was missing and a speaker not belonging to them was on the front seat.



Driver was identified and released on three summons: eluding at low speed, failure to move over for stationary emergency vehicle, and driving without a license.

Ashburn	Fraud: The victim reported that a male subject contacted them stating that he was with Dominion Virginia Power and the victim was behind on their bill. The victim did as instructed prior to checking their bills and realizing it was a scam.


