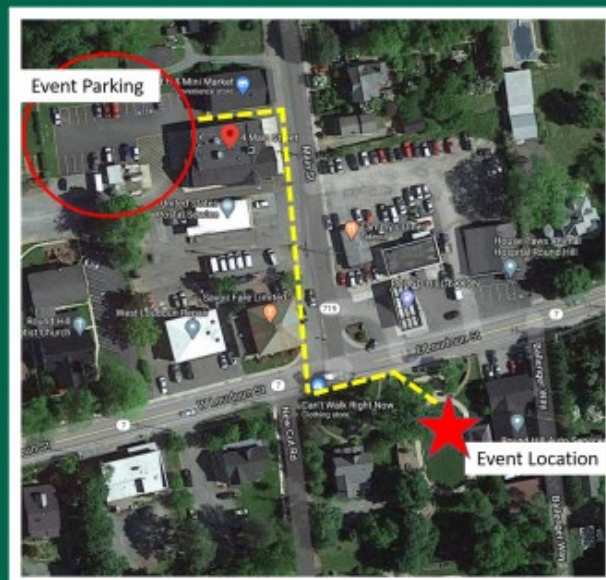
Event Location

In front of the Town Park Pavilion at Loudoun Street Park in the Town of Round Hill. Parking is available behind the Round Hill Fire Station at 4 Main Street. From the parking lot, walk approximately 0.2 miles across Loudoun Street to the Pavilion.

Directions

From Route 7, take the exit toward Round Hill and merge onto Route 7 Business West/East Loudoun Street. Drive approximately .4 miles to the marked-off ribbon cutting site at Loudoun Street Park.

(If navigating to the event location using GPS, use 3 East Loudoun Street, Round Hill, Va. 20141 to arrive at the general location.)



About the Round Hill to Franklin Park Trail & Main Street Enhancements Project

The project includes the design and construction of sidewalks and a shared-use path (pedestrian and bicycle) from the center of the Town of Round Hill to Franklin Park in western Loudoun County. This link will include concrete sidewalks along both sides of East Loudoun Street and Main Street to the location of the former W&OD railroad station.

In addition, the project includes county management of the Town of Round Hill's Main Street pedestrian and streetscape project. Additional Main Street and East Loudoun Street enhancements include curbs, curb ramps, retaining walls and a new storm drainage system.
