The Town of Hillsboro has issued the following message related to a house fire causing the closure of Route 9 between Hillsboro Road (Rt 690) and Stony Point Road (Rt 719).

There is a fire at the old church in the center of Hillsboro. Residents are safe. Emergency personnel have closed access to Hillsboro. Please avoid the area.

Loudoun County Fire and Rescue remains on the scene.

According to Alert Loudoun notification, please avoid the area. Roads leading to this area will continue to be closed for an estimated 4 to 5 hours. Thank you.
