

Purcellville	Traffic Checking Detail: This detail was a joint effort between LCSO and Virginia State Police to enforce both moving and non-moving violations. The results of it are as follows: A total of 956 vehicles passed through the checking area. A total of 40 drivers were further screened. 8 drivers were issued a notice for not having a Loudoun County Decal or displaying one which was expired. 6 drivers were issued summons for operating vehicles with expired registrations. 21 drivers were issued a summons for having an expired inspection sticker displayed. 2 drivers were cited for having an expired Operators License. 1 driver who tried to avoid the checkpoint by making a U-turn across the double solid yellow line was stopped and issued a summons for Reckless Driving. 1 driver was arrested for operating a vehicle with a Revoked-DUI Related license.
