





The victim received a text arranging for the care of the animals followed by a check for \$2950.00 dollars. "Gloria George" told the victim to deposit the check and send back \$1400 via Moneygram and \$1100 via Western Union to Chidozie Ewelukwa for fees to transport the dogs. A few days later, "Gloria" asked to send another \$1000 because of more unforeseen costs.
