Belmont Ridge Road (Truro Parish - Croson Lane) Widening Project Update

Traffic Shifts on Belmont Ridge Road (Beginning Late March)

Cochrans Lock Drive Right Turn Lane Closure (April 1 - 9)

Traffic Shifts on Belmont Ridge Road (On or About March 30 - April 9)

On or about March 30, 2023 through April 9, 2023, Belmont Ridge Road northbound and southbound traffic will be switched onto a **new roadway alignment between Croson Lane and Reservoir Ridge Place.**

Lanes will be a single lane in each direction using both temporary crossover lanes and newly paved travel lanes. [See diagram below.](#)

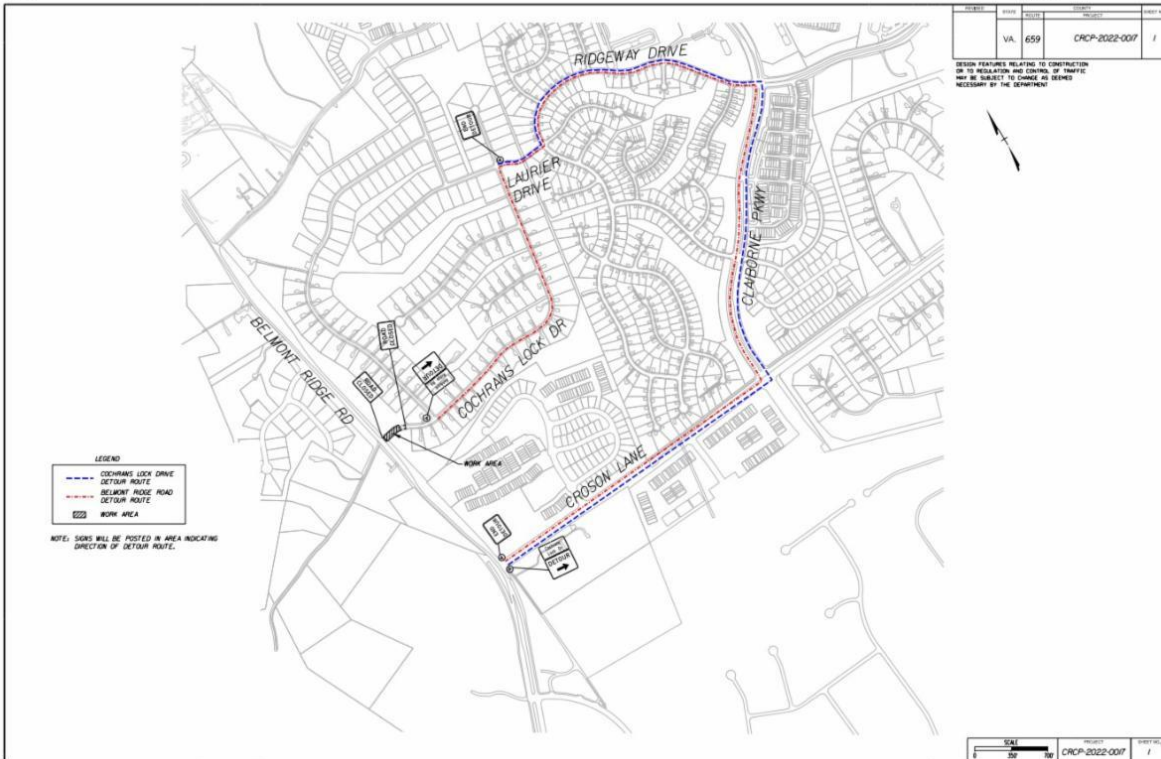


Map Key

Additionally, the **northbound Belmont Ridge Road right turn lane on to Cochran's Lock Drive will be closed from April 1, 2023 through April 9, 2023.** To reach Cochran's Lock Drive, drivers will need to follow the posted detour. [See detour map below.](#)



Drivers should use extra caution and slow down when traveling through these areas. Please follow all directions from the posted detour signs and road crews as heavy construction is underway and residents are entering and exiting their neighborhoods off Belmont Ridge Road between Croson Lane and Truro Parish Drive.

About the Project:

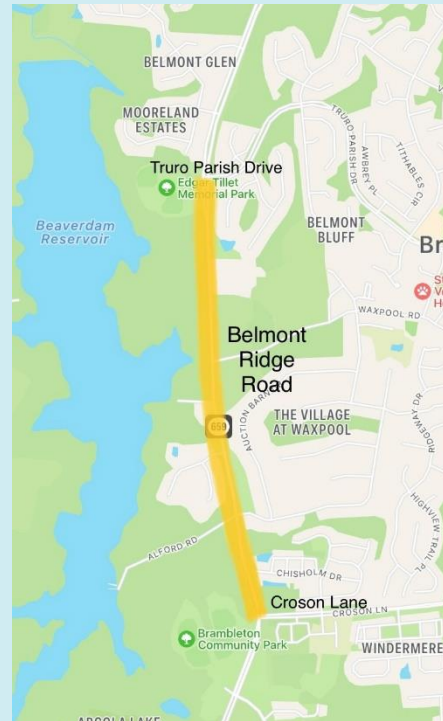
This project designs and constructs two additional lanes of Belmont Ridge Road from Truro Parish Drive to Croson Lane. The improvements will consist of reconstructing and widening the existing two-lane roadway to a four-lane divided roadway with a ten foot shared use path on both sides.

The Project includes two northbound and two southbound lanes, associated turn lanes at the intersections of Croson Lane, Cochrans Lock Drive, Reservoir Ridge Place, Mount Hope Road, Waxpool Road, Black Angus Drive, Truro Parish Drive, a grass median, stormwater management facilities, landscaping, and modifications to the existing traffic signals at Croson Lane and Truro Parish Drive.

Construction is currently estimated to be completed in Summer 2024, weather permitting.

Project Significance:

- The corridor is one of four major north/south roadways in Loudoun County (along with Route 15, Loudoun County Parkway and Route 28) and has been designated by the Commonwealth of Virginia as a "Corridor of Statewide Significance."
- The project provides shared use paths alongside Belmont Ridge in accordance with the Countywide Transportation Plan (CTP). The shared use paths will ultimately provide continuous access to/from the W&OD Regional Trail.
- The widening from two to four lanes will increase safety and reduce traffic congestion.



- The project upgrades a rural sub-standard two lane roadway to modern safety and level of service standards.
- The 1.5 mile segment of widening represents the last section of two lane Belmont Ridge Roadway between Route 7 and Evergreen Mills Road.
- Combined with the future completion of Northstar Boulevard, this will provide a continuous four lane divided roadway between Route 7 and Route 50.
