Route 7/West of Turnberry Dr.	<p>Fatal Crash: The driver of a Toyota Corolla was attempting to pull out of a driveway to cross the median crossover of Route 7 to travel east on Route 7. The driver pulled out in front of a driver of a 2005 Mack tractor-trailer that was westbound. The truck attempted to swerve and struck the front of the Toyota. The truck then went down on its side before righting and then jackknifed. The engine compartment and cabin of the truck became fully engulfed in flames. The driver of the truck, Thomas D. Taylor, 36, of Timberville, Va. lost his life at the scene. The driver of the Toyota was taken to a local hospital and then was transferred to Inova Fairfax Hospital for treatment for non-life-threatening injuries. The crash remains under investigation. The roadway was closed for nearly 10 hours for crash investigation and scene clean-up. One eastbound lane was converted to a westbound lane by LCSO personnel to alleviate traffic in the area.</p>
