
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Incident Report







A tree that the hammock was fastened to fell forward on top of the children. One child was airlifted to Inova Fairfax Hospital with the second child being taken to Inova Fairfax Hospital by ground. The child who was airlifted from the scene later succumbed to her injuries. The second child received minor injuries. A preliminary investigation has determined the case was a tragic accident. <p>09/23/18 0028 hrs.</p>	<p>17300 block Dry Mill Rd. Leesburg</p>	<p>Check the Welfare/Assault on Law Enforcement: An Ashburn man is facing charges after assaulting an LCSO Deputy. A deputy observed a male in the roadway near the listed location. As the deputy was preparing to arrest the subject for drunk in public, the suspect charged the deputy forcing him to the ground. After both males fell to the ground, the suspect struck the deputy. After a physical struggle, the suspect fled into the woods and the deputy gave chase. Additional deputies along with members of the Virginia State Police and the Fairfax County Police Department helicopter assisted with setting up a perimeter to locate the suspect. An LCSO K-9 unit conducted a track and the K-9 Team located the suspect hiding inside a shed. The suspect was given lawful commands and did not comply. The K-9 deployed into the shed and located the suspect hiding under a cardboard box. The suspect was taken to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries which resulted from the altercation and fleeing the scene. He remains hospitalized. The deputy was treated for his injuries at a local hospital and was later released. Arrest warrants for Felonious Assault on Law Enforcement, Resisting Arrest, Attempting to Disarm a Law Enforcement Officer, Trespassing, Possession of Marijuana and Public Intoxication are pending. He also facing outstanding warrants in Fairfax County. SO180017544</p>
