



Loudoun County Transit Is Accepting Recommendations for New Bus Routes

Loudoun County is accepting suggestions from the public for new and improved bus routes through their "Tell Us Where You Want To Go" program. These new routes would go into effect in 2017. Suggestions can include modifications to existing routes or brand new service in places where there is no service.

There are limited resources, so not all suggested routes will be developed and the changes won't be able to happen immediately. The Board of Supervisors must endorse and approve the funding for the recommended routes. If the Board approves the suggested routes, they will be included in the Fiscal Year 2018 budget with service scheduled to begin in July of 2017.

VDOT Transform 66 Inside the Beltway Public Hearings

The Virginia Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation, will host ***Design Public Hearings for the Transform 66 Inside the Beltway Project***. Improvements involve converting I-66 to dynamically-priced toll lanes in the peak direction during morning (eastbound) and afternoon (westbound) rush hours between I-495 (the Capital Beltway) and U.S. Route 29 in Rosslyn, along with implementing a series of multi modal improvements that will benefit toll users of I-66.

The hearings will be held on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, March 9, 6:00-8:00 pm** (VDOT Northern Virginia District Office (4975 Alliance Drive, Fairfax, VA 22030)
