



FLEETWOOD ROAD REOPENING

***Newly paved surface from Revival Drive to a short distance south of
Evergreen Mills Road***

I wanted to let you know that Fleetwood Road will reopen to through traffic the evening of Wednesday, August 24th (weather permitting). Many thanks to VDOT for working with my office to accelerate this project by at least a month.

The road has been closed to through traffic since June 1st in order to repair ditches and replace nearly two miles of gravel surface with pavement. The newly paved surface extends north from Revival Drive to a point located approximately a quarter mile south of Evergreen Mills Road where it will eventually be connected with the existing Langley Oaks Drive per our Countywide Transportation Plan. The current unpaved portion of Fleetwood Road will remain open and available for local and through traffic.

The project was carried out under VDOT's [Rural Rustic Road Program](#), which aims to preserve the traditional feel of a rural road while making surface and other improvements within the current right-of-way.
