



Round Hill Considers Expansion: Complete Town's Online Survey!

I wanted to inform you that the town of Round Hill is looking into the possibility of expanding its corporate limits. Round Hill currently consists of 255 households, and is considering a short-term addition of up to approximately 500 more households from the Joint Land Management Area located outside the Town. Round Hill is also considering the addition of certain key public facilities such as the Round Hill Center, the Western Loudoun Sheriff's Station, the future site of Round Hill Volunteer Fire Department, and two future Town parks.

The Town held its [first public information](#) (click link to view news article) session at Round Hill Elementary School on August 3rd. The Town has plans for a second public information session and additional public outreach before it makes a decision as to which, if any, properties it will seek to add to its jurisdiction.

As any annexation decision approved by the Town will ultimately come before the Board of Supervisors for action, my office is following the Town's process. That said, I want to encourage engagement in the public process in order to ensure that your voice is heard.
