

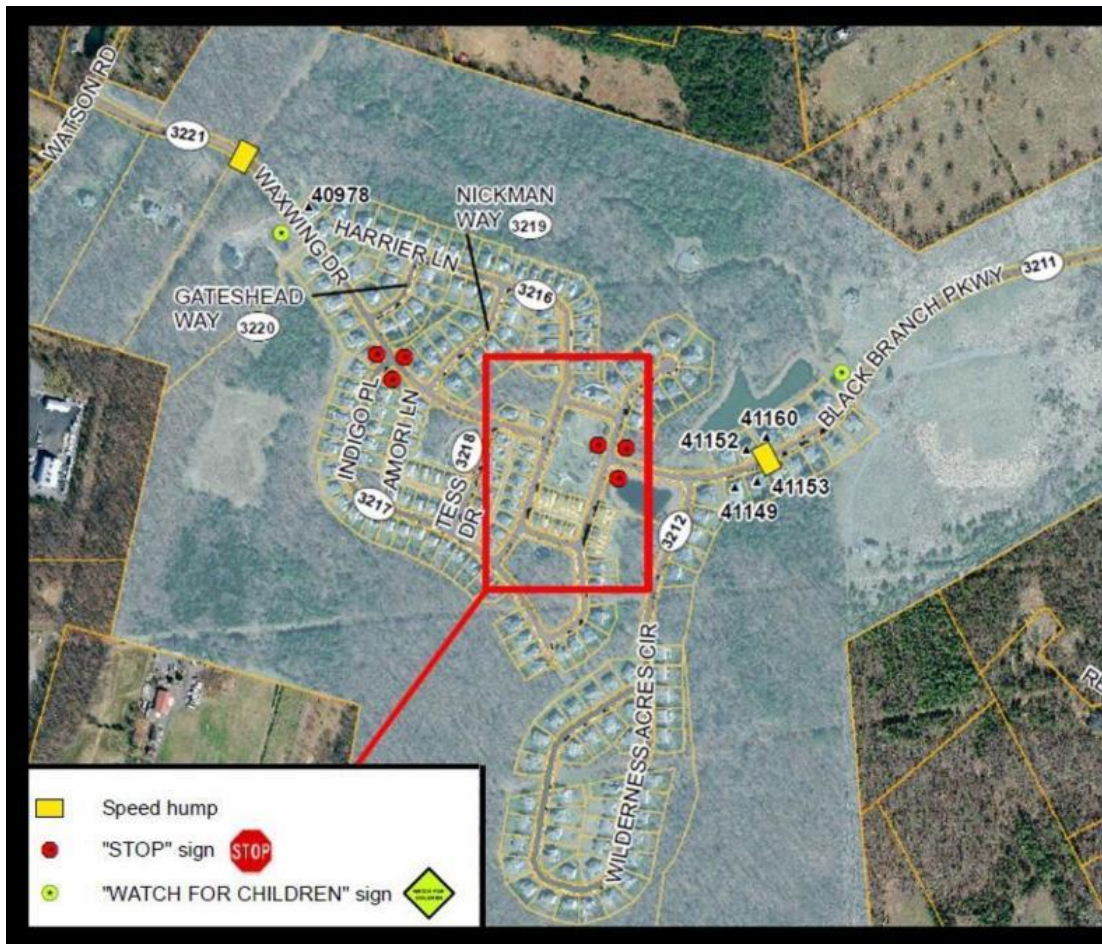
Traffic Calming Measures Unanimously Approved for the Community of Green Mill Preserve!

March 23, 2018

I am happy to report that after a little over a year and a half of working to address speeding, safety and cut-through traffic within the Green Mill Preserve Community, the Board of Supervisors voted unanimously last night to authorize use of \$27,000 for the installation of speed humps, multi-way stop signs, and "*Watch for Children*" signs throughout the Green Mill Preserve Community as depicted in the below diagram.

It is my hope that these measures will work to increase safety and reduce cut-through traffic and speed within

Green Mill Preserve. I would like to thank the HOA and the many residents who signed the necessary petition in order to meet the necessary 75% criteria for participation in the VDOT Traffic Calming Program. I would also like to thank County staff for the many hours of work spent coordinating with my office, the community and VDOT in order to make this happen.
