



Traffic Calming Measures Unanimously Approved for the Evergreen Hamlet Community!

I am happy to report that after just over a year of working to reduce excessive speeds within the Evergreen Hamlet community, the Board of Supervisors voted unanimously last night to authorize use of \$22,040 for the installation of speed humps and *"Watch for Children"* signs along Conservancy Drive.

It is my hope that these measures will result in increased safety and reduced speeds within the community. I would like to thank the HOA and the many residents who signed the necessary petition in order to meet VDOT's 75% criteria for participation in the Traffic Calming Program. I

would also like to thank County staff for the many hours spent coordinating with my office, VDOT and the community in order to make this happen.
