Dear Sheriff Chapman,

I am writing to you as I wanted to call your attention to the 3 superb deputies you have working at the ADF.

Unfortunately, I was at the ADF to drop off my daughter. She was supposed to serve 12 hrs for "reckless with speed": 101 in a 55. She was told by Judge Welch on Wed 7/20 to report to the ADF at 7 AM on Fri 7/22. I brought her to the ADF at 6:45 AM on Fri 7/22 and was told that the ADF didn't have any paperwork for her. Deputy Weilheit (spelling? (~6'2". 225 lbs, shaved head) came out and talked to us. Deputy Weilheit did some additional research and found the paperwork on my daughter: however; it was for a Fri 7/22 7 PM show and it was for 14 hrs.

My daughter contacted her lawyer and he supposedly had the clerk correct the time of arrival error and length of stay error. She was now supposed to report on Sat 7/23 for 12 hours.

She reported to the ADF on Sat at 6:45 AM. The intake deputies, Deputy Hart (female) and a male deputy whose name I did not see told us that their paperwork had my daughter there for 26 hours. As it was a Sat, my daughter had little choice: she turned herself in and served the 26 hours.

Your 3 deputies were professional and courteous. They understood our plight and offered what little advice they could.

I would ask that you pass on my thanks and appreciation to these deputies for their understanding and assistance. With deputies such as these, I know the county is in excellent hands.




