

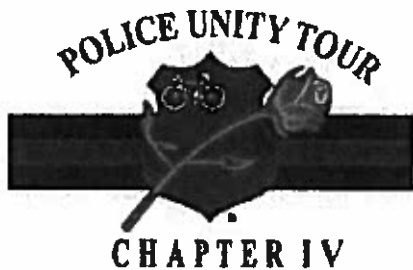
The K-9 units were exceptionally thorough, professional and respectful. Their performance helped maintain the security and well being of not only the graduates but the volunteers as well.

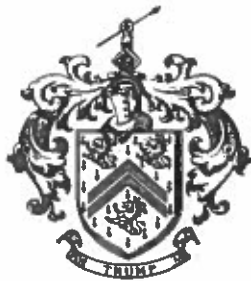
Explain the circumstances on why you are paying this compliment:

I had left work early as I was having a severe episode of diverticulitis and needed to make it home as the pains were increasing. As I was driving on route 7 to exit onto route 9 I received another abdominal pain and almost missed my exit to join route 9. I realized at that point that I committed an infraction by speeding up more than the allowed speed limit trying to get to my exit of route 9. The pain just did not let me think straight to be quite honest so I had exceeded the speed limit and was pulled over by Deputy Alpy. I spoke with Deputy Alpy about what was happening to me which he understood as he has the same symptoms and understood what I was going through. Deputy Alpy gave me a warning and advised to ensure I get home (following the speed limits, of course) take some medication to which I am grateful. It is so vital that the clinicians in the CITAC and law enforcement can work together seamlessly and today was a perfect example! I really appreciate him and the work that he did with me today!!
