I had been unfortunately involved in a year long struggle with another South Riding Resident, and past Dear Friend. Unfortunately that struggling situation, along with my bad health, and the passing of my parent , all came to one large climax the evening of November 1st 2016, when that evening a and to my surprise Deputy Carpenter arrived at my home to serve a warrant against me, and taken out by the other party. Deputy Carpenter, on her own ,and very quickly ,realized her appearance and announcement had a sudden and serious effect on my already bad health. Deputy Carpenter quickly switched modalities of her purpose for coming out to my home. Without request she called for medical assistance which it turned out I was very much in need of. It was only after her quick actions in getting EMS. to the scene was she told by my friend of my health conditions, and a brief description as to why her presence had the effect on me that it had. She was extremely helpful and concerned for my well being . She simply ask when i was released from the hospital to please turn myself in. I did as instructed and the legal process played itself out, ending in all charges against me dismissed and expunged for they were bogus charges. I have had a few scares or two at my home since and she has shown up and as always was kind, helpful, and has always taken my concerns seriously. I can not imagine how the night of November 1st, may had played out, had the deputy been any one other then Deputy Carpenter. With many thanks [REDACTED]

He replied that he had not and Gravatte gave him a sandwich. He told him it was fresh from Puccios. He then walked back inside and brought him a bottle of water. The man was clearly grateful. After witnessing the exchange, I went back inside to speak to the deputy. He was enjoying his lunch (the other half of the sandwich). He told me that the man was homeless and that he has seen him there over the past few months. He also told me that he's brought him in to let him warm up and even given him his own hat on a cold day. I commend this deputy for going above and beyond for this homeless gentleman. I ran back to the pantry and packed up a bag of food and information about where he can get services and the deputy assured me he'd relay the information and the food next time he sees him. Deputy Gravatte demonstrated that simple acts of kindness can make a difference in our community.
