



**Envision Loudoun Open Houses!
(Third Round of Public Input)**



We want to hear from you again Loudoun!

A draft version of our new Comprehensive Plan has been published and a series of community open houses are set to begin next week. Please consider attending an open house in order to provide your input.

In addition to an opportunity to provide online comment (beginning May 14), the County will host open houses from May 14 until May 24 of 2018. These open houses will provide additional opportunities for public comment regarding the draft plan. The open houses have been designed to provide an opportunity for residents to speak directly with county staff in order to learn more about the draft Plan and to provide their input.

The following open houses will be held from 6:30 until 8:30 pm:

- **Monday, May 14, 2018:** Harmony Middle School, 38174 W Colonial Highway, Hamilton
- **Wednesday, May 16, 2018:** Harper Park Middle School, 701 Potomac Station Drive, Leesburg
- **Thursday, May 24, 2018:** John Champe High School, 41535 Sacred Mountain Street, Aldie

The following open house will be held from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm:

- **Monday, May 21, 2018:** Loudoun Government Center, Dulles Room (first floor), 1 Harrison Street, SE, Leesburg

Upon conclusion of the open houses an updated draft version of the plan will be presented to the County's Planning Commission for further public comment, review and recommendation, prior to presentation to the Board of Supervisors where the public will once again have a chance to comment before final adoption of the new Plan in early 2019.

Once adopted, the new Plan will be named the "Loudoun 2040 Comprehensive Plan" and will include the County's General and the Countywide Transportation Plans. The newly adopted Plan will then serve as Loudoun's guide for land use and transportation decisions into the foreseeable future.
