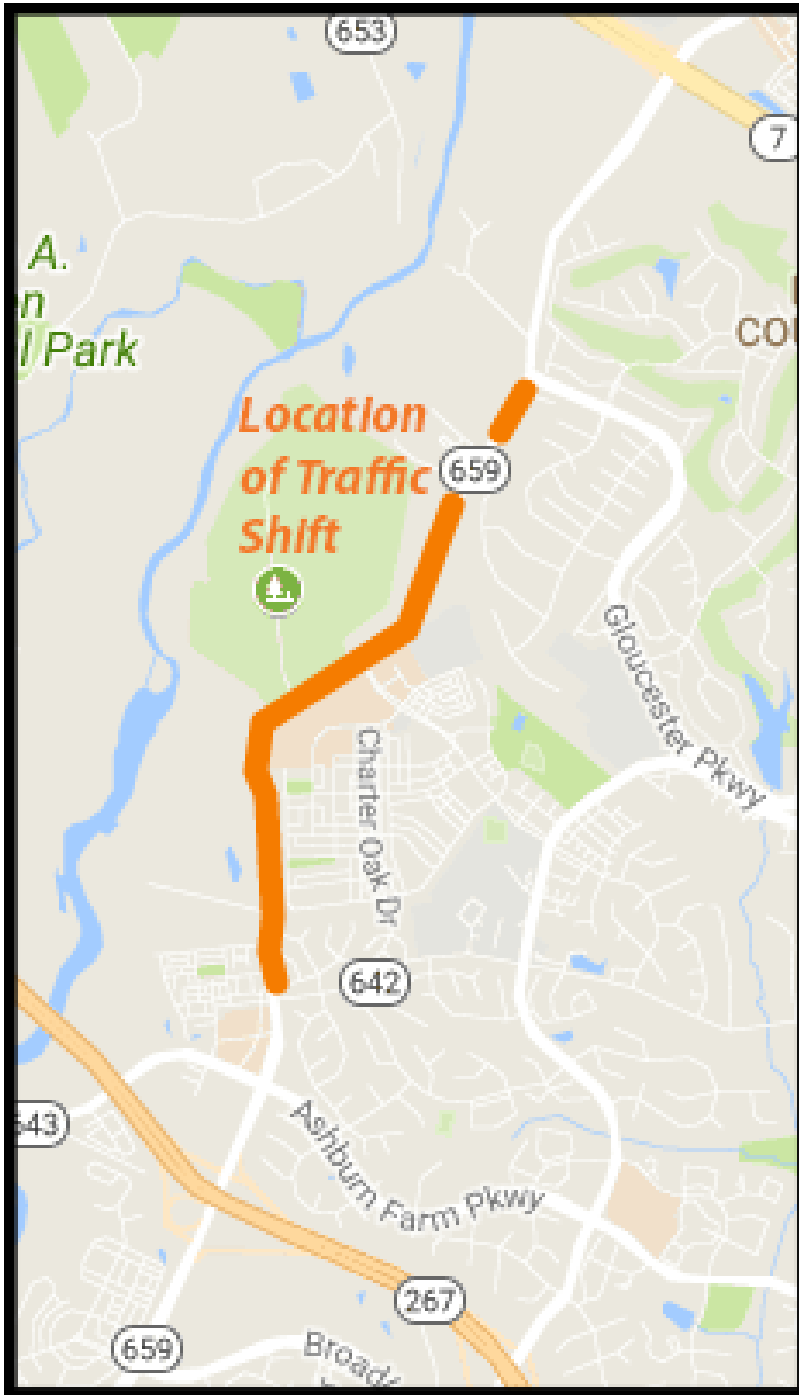


BELMONT RIDGE ROAD TRAFFIC SHIFT





September 13, 2018

Per VDOT, southbound traffic on Belmont Ridge Rd between Gloucester Pkwy and Hay Rd will shift to newly constructed southbound lanes of the new median-divided roadway and to the new southbound bridge over the Washington & Old Dominion Trail on Tuesday, Sept. 18 between 9:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. (weather permitting).

Temporary stoppages will be needed for the traffic shift. Drivers should expect delays and are advised to use alternate routes.

Southbound traffic between Gloucester Pkwy and Hay Rd will continue to be one lane; the northbound traffic pattern between Hay Rd and Gloucester Pkwy, which is unaffected by Thursday's traffic shift, will also continue to be one lane.

The shift is part of the Belmont Ridge Rd widening project which is scheduled for completion by the end of the year.
