



I wanted to update you on construction work that will be occurring over the next two days at the Davis Drive Substation. Dominion Energy has provided my office a statement regarding this activity. The statement includes an email and phone number to field questions and concerns.

#### **Dominion statement on Davis Drive Substation Construction Activity**

Dominion Energy is working to complete the construction of the Davis Drive Substation which is located in the TransDulles Business Park on the south side of the Washington and Old Dominion (W&OD) Trail in Loudoun County. The substation will provide electric service to a new data center campus and additional reliability to surrounding residential and commercial customers.

The current phase of the project requires the installation of a new transmission monopole in front of the substation and adjacent to the W&OD Trail. This will allow for electric connection between the substation and the transmission line along the trail.

Dominion contractors need to complete the drilling of a foundation hole for the monopole. This work has taken longer than expected due to extremely dense rock below the surface. In order to complete the monopole installation on time, the drilling must be completed within the next few days. As a result, construction crews will be drilling the last few feet of the foundation hole on a 24-hour schedule starting the evening of Monday, August 13th. This 24-hour work schedule will continue for approximately two days.

Dominion must complete the work in a limited time frame to allow for electric connection while the transmission line is out of service.

The company apologizes for this inconvenience to nearby residents, and pledges to work efficiently and safely to complete the monopole installation.
