



Dear Sterling District Residents,

I wanted to provide an update on the situation on Jennings Farm Drive and Maple Leaf Place. This has been an issue of great concern to many constituents and resolving this has been a priority of mine. It was unacceptable that commercial vehicles parked on the side of the road were creating a safety risk for residents as well as an eye sore. In March the Board of Supervisors passed my initiative in a 9-0 vote. However, there unfortunately was a delay created by red tape associated with state procurement laws. My office worked closely with County transportation staff on alternatives to complete the work as soon as possible.

I am pleased to announce that work on the first phase of this project will begin soon. Effective October 15, 2018, on-street parking will no longer be allowed on Jennings Farm Drive and Maple Leaf Place. Any parked vehicles will be towed by the County. Signage will be posted and notifications to property owners will be sent in advance to provide a reminder of this date. Moreover, on October 15, 2018, the County's contractor will begin a pavement marking and signage project to stripe the roadways to remove all on-street parking. This will be done Monday through Friday from 7 AM to 3:30 PM through November 2, 2018. Work will include temporary lane closures, although I want to note that access to all properties will be maintained during this process. Motorists are advised to watch for signage as well as flaggers during the performance of the work.
