



Dedicated Left Turn Signal Approved!



November 27, 2018

In September, myself and Purcellville Mayor Fraser made a joint request that VDOT add a dedicated left turn arrow signal for northbound Rt 287 traffic wishing to turn left onto westbound Rt 7.

I'm happy to report that our request has been approved and should be implemented on Thursday, November 29 (weather dependent).

Please note that this is an interim improvement until the \$11 million Rt 7/Rt 287 Interchange improvement project that I was able to get funded and added to the County's Capital Improvement Program is designed and constructed. Design work began this summer with funding received in FY19. Construction funding is scheduled to be received from VDOT in FY22 and FY23. As always, I will work to accelerate receipt of construction funding and will keep you informed as progress is made.
