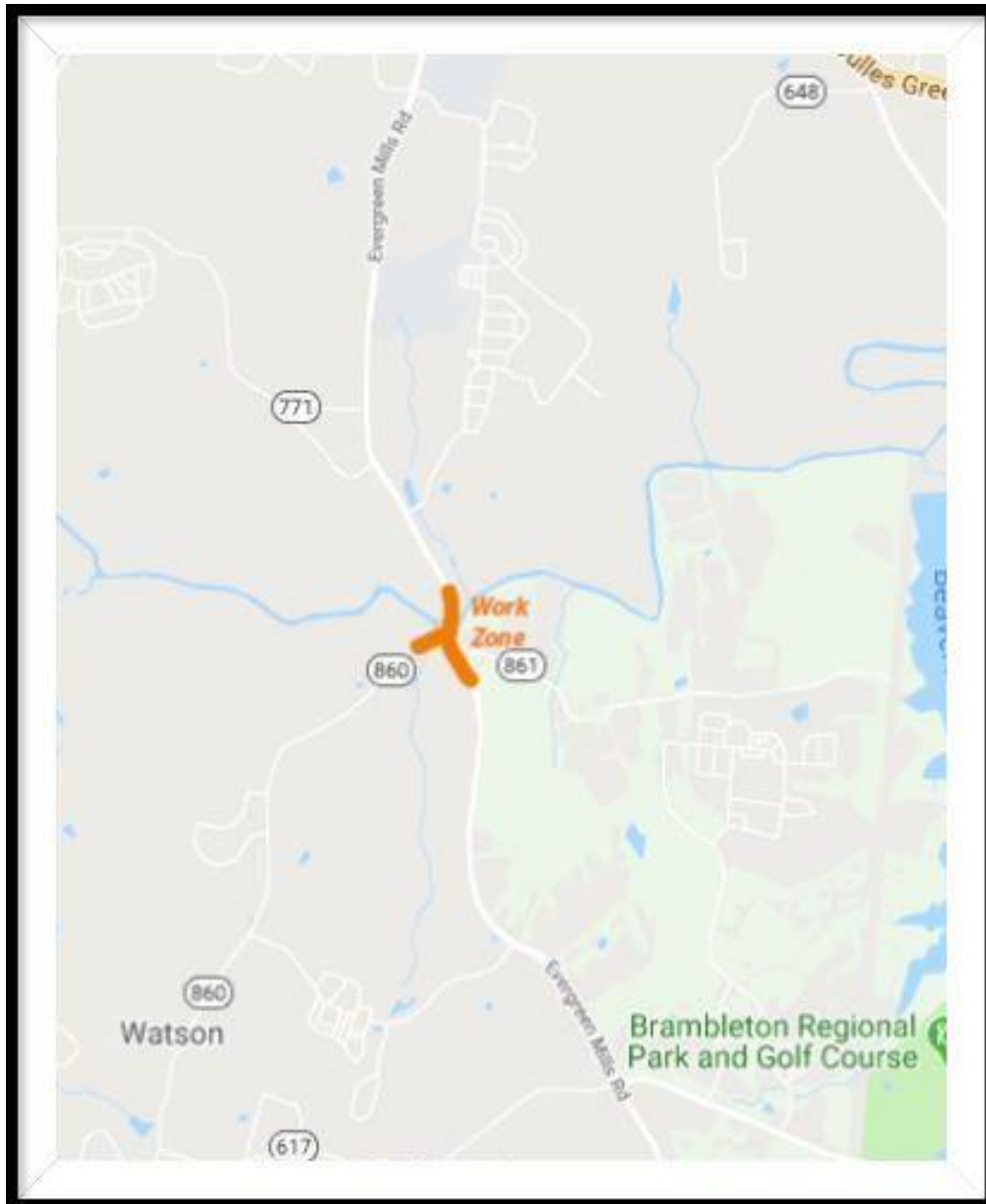




**INTERSECTION FLAGGING OPERATIONS
FOR DYNAMIC WARNING FLASHER
INSTALLATION AT INTERSECTION OF
EVERGREEN MILLS & WATSON ROAD**

Safety Improvements

VDOT will soon install the Dynamic Warning Flasher system I've been telling you about since March of 2017, in order to improve safety by alerting

northbound Evergreen Mills Road drivers to out-of-sight vehicles stopped at the bottom of the hill, waiting to turn left onto southbound Watson Road.

Specifically, the project will replace the temporary 24x7 battery operated yellow flashing lights on the northbound Evergreen Mills Road approach to Watson Road, with electrically powered sensor controlled flashing lights that will only flash when vehicles are stopped either at the bottom of northbound Evergreen Mills Road, waiting to turn left onto southbound Watson Road or at the end of Watson Road, waiting to turn left or right onto Evergreen Mills Road.

The project is also expected to replace the temporary 24x7 battery operated red flashing lights on the eastbound Watson Road approach to Evergreen Mills Road, with permanent 24x7 electrically powered red flashing lights.

Based on VDOT's analysis, these improvements are expected to reduce rear end, and angle crashes at the intersection.

Flagging Operation

Per VDOT, **drivers should expect 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. weekday only flagging operations at the intersection of Evergreen Mills & Watson Road from June 24 - July 12**, in order to facilitate installation of Dynamic Warning Flashers.

Drivers should expect delays and are advised to use alternate routes during this improvement period.
