Please join myself and others this Saturday morning (June 29, 2019) at 11:00 a.m. for the official Ground-Breaking Ceremony to begin construction of Loudoun's new 257-acre Hal & Berni Hanson Regional Park located on both sides of Evergreen Mills Road between the communities of Brambleton & Willowsford!

The park will feature 17 sports fields, 5 courts, 75 acres of wooded park with trails, dog parks, playgrounds, pavilions, picnic shelters, skate plaza, splash pad, lakes, nature center, restored historic home, and more!

Currently, construction is expected to end around Spring of 2022.

Where do I go for the Ground-Breaking???

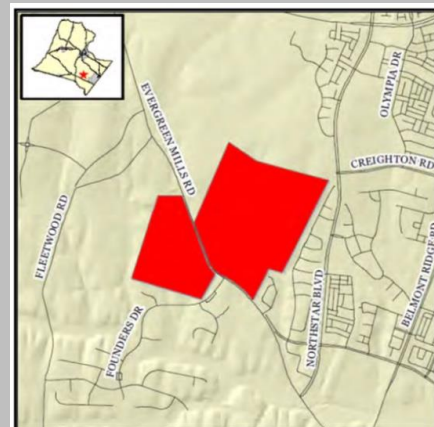
Signs will be posted on Evergreen Mills Road between Founders Drive and Fleetwood Drive to direct you to the event entrance.

I'm happy to share with you that last night my colleagues and I took action to **approve and fully fund Hal & Berni Hanson Park!** This new regional public park will provide both active and passive recreation on 257 acres located on both sides of Evergreen Mills Road, between the Brambleton and Willowsford communities!

The project will provide for design & construction of:

- 10 rectangular grass soccer fields
- 1 cricket field
- 4 tennis courts

- 4 diamond fields
- 2 championship turf fields
- 1 basketball court
- 2 playgrounds
- 1 splash pad
- 1 skate plaza
- 9 restroom facilities
- Grandstands
- Concession buildings
- Park offices
- Maintenance facilities
- Pavilions
- Picnic shelters
- Dog parks
- A park lodge
- A nature center
- Restoration of the historic Hanson Farm House
- Evergreen Mills Road improvements
- 75 acres of passive park with paved & natural trails
- Restoration of 5 existing lakes

Construction is expected to begin on June 30, 2019, and end around Spring of 2022.
