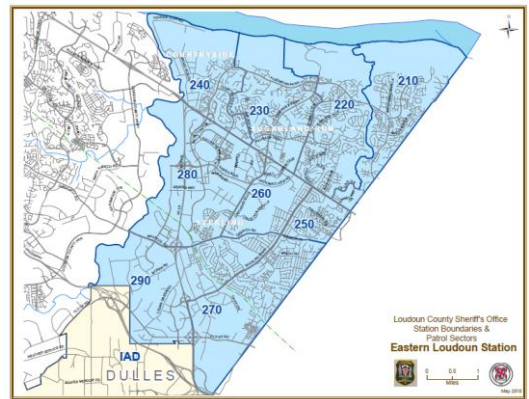
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Crime Report

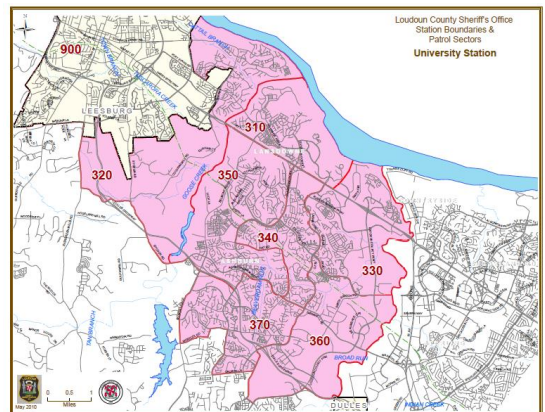

Ashburn Station

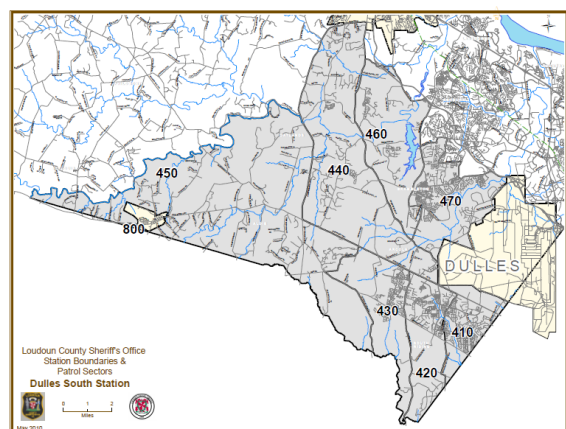

Ashburn	Fraud: A victim reported he was contacted by a male claiming to work for the Social Security Administration and that the victim's social security number had been compromised. The suspect told the victim to purchase gift cards and provide him with the activation code in order to obtain a new social security number. The victim provided the codes before realizing it was a scam. SO190017297
9/18/2019 1722 hrs.	44000 Block Riverside Pkwy. Leesburg	Public Intoxication: Deputies responded for reports of an intoxicated male attempting to walk out of the hospital. Mohit Arora, 32, of Vienna was charged with Public Intoxication and was later released from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center on a Personal Recognizance Bond. SO190017289
9/18/2019 0927 hrs.	44100 Block Ashburn Shopping Plz. Ashburn	Assault: A victim reported he was approached in a parking lot by a female, who was known to him, and five males, some of whom were known to him. The female and three males surrounded the victim, made threats towards him, and assaulted him. The victim advised he was able to free himself and flee the scene on foot. The victim later reported the incident to law enforcement. The victim did not sustain any injuries. The four suspects were identified and two were located. Christian T. Knock, 20, of Ashburn and Summer Mirzian, 19, of Ashburn were charged with Assault by Mob. Knock was later released from the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center on a \$1,500 bond and Mirzian on a Personal Recognizance Bond. Charges against two other suspects are still outstanding. 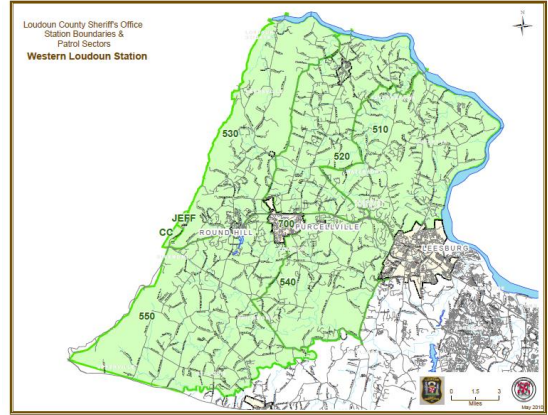
