



Overnight Closures for Hirst Road in Purcellville on February 26 & 27

Good morning!

In response to my recent request for the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to take action to correct the standing water drainage issue at the corner of Hirst Road & Route 287 in Purcellville, VDOT has taken immediate action to unclog the drainage pipe beneath Route 287, and has advised of additional action to improve the Hirst Road drainage ditch that leads to the corner of Hirst Road & Route 287.

Drainage Issues at the Intersection of Hirst Road and 287



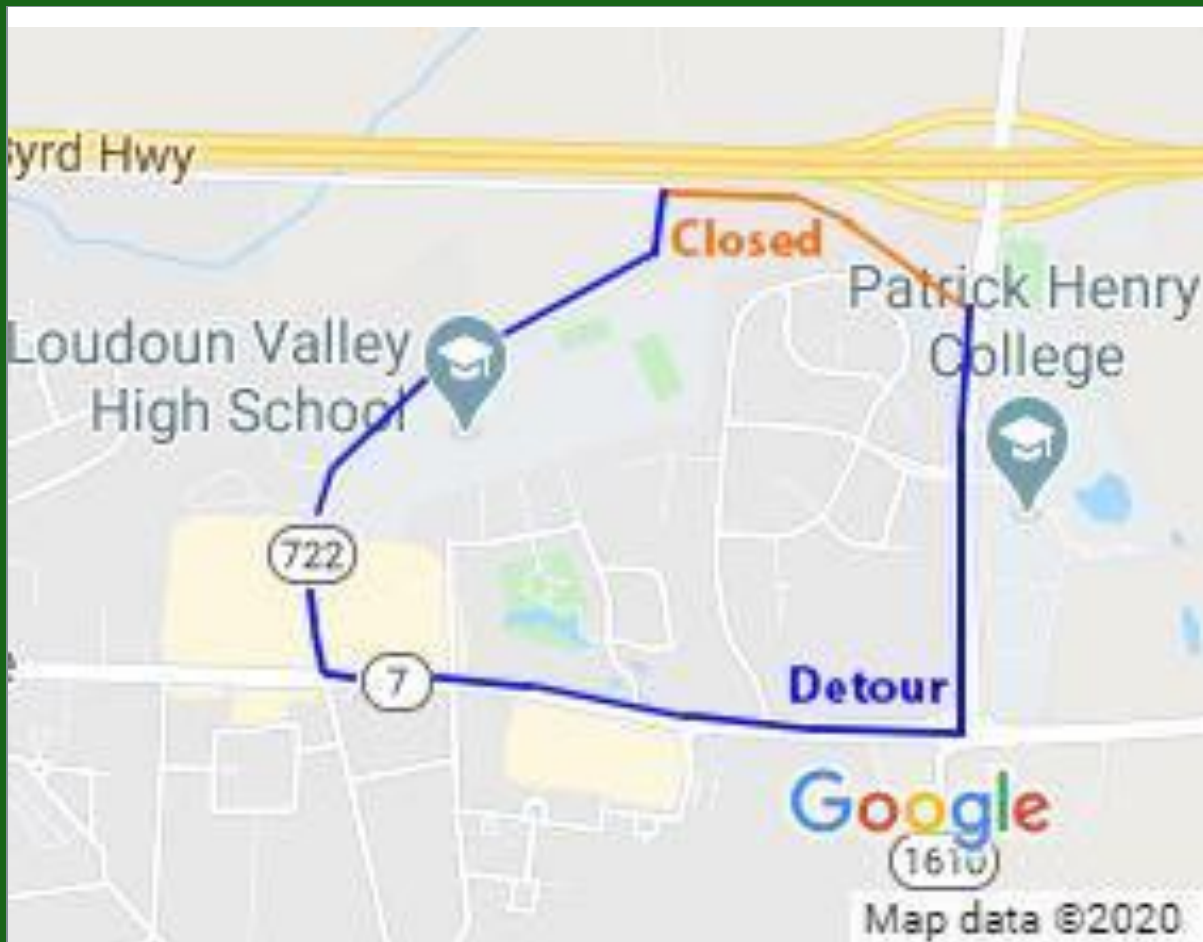
The additional work to further improve the Hirst Road drainage ditch will occur (weather permitting) on Wednesday, February 26 and Thursday, February 27, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly.

To facilitate this work, VDOT will initiate nightly road closures between North Maple Avenue and Route 287 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

Please note that those needing local access to properties along Hirst Road during the closures will be allowed access, and that use of the Washington & Old Dominion Trail will not be impacted by this work.
