



Planned Venting at Loudoun Compressor Station Tomorrow Morning

March 10, 2020

Good afternoon!

I wanted to make you aware that on Wednesday, March 11th, at 9:00 a.m., Dominion Energy will conduct a scheduled natural gas venting from its Loudoun Compressor Station located along Watson Road. Below is a message from Dominion regarding its scheduled venting operation:

This is a message to our neighbors in the vicinity of Dominion Energy Transmission's Loudoun Compressor Station on Cove Point Lane off of Watson Road in Loudoun County:

Dominion Energy will be performing a required annual test of the Emergency Shutdown System at the Loudoun Compressor Station. This requires venting natural gas from the piping within the station. The compressor station's silencers and carbon filters will be used to mitigate noise and odor during the test.

The test is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, March 11th, and is expected to last less than 30 minutes.

Thank you for your understanding as we work to ensure the safe and efficient operation of our facilities.
